 - 3. Letter of recommendation from the applicant's sponsoring choral director

Applications sent via mail must be <u>received</u> by January 5, 2019.

- Applicants will complete their scholarship audition during the rehearsal at Rowan University on Thursday, January 10, 2019. The audition consists of an aria or art song performed from memory. Applicants are responsible for providing their own accompanist or a recorded accompaniment.
- The scholarship winner will be announced at the conclusion of the Saturday evening festival concert.
- The scholarship winner is expected to perform their audition selection at the annual SJCDA general membership breakfast meeting on April 12, 2019.
- The recipient must also successfully complete one music course at the collegiate level within one year of having been awarded the scholarship. The financial award will be disbursed only after the recipient has completed these requirements.
