EE Route Sheet Holder Installation Instructions



- Installation on bikes with Fat Bars or bikes that do not have a crossbar. Place Roll Chart Holder over left side of handle bars, the bar will fit into the cradle of the rubber hose and clamp. (Fig 1)
- Installation on bikes with crossbar. Using a pair of scissors cut the 3/8 hose long ways. (Fig 2)
- Install cut hose to crossbar. (Fig 3) Place Roll Chart Holder over hose on cross bar this will fit in the cradle of the hose and the clamp. (Fig 4)
- Using 8mm nut drive or socket tighten hose clamp. (Fig 5)
- Installing Route Sheet to carrier, with knobs on the left side, place a small piece of tape to the sheet and wrap it around the lower rod. (Fig 6) Rotate the knob counter clockwise until the route sheet is rolled up on rod. Now place a small piece of tape on the other end of route sheet and wrap it around the top rod. (Fig 7) (Fig 8) this is how the carrier and route sheet should look, now you are ready to load carrier into the holder.
- 6 Place the carrier into the holder from the left side. (Fig 9)
- Install right side plate. (Fig 10)
- Install and tighten wing nut. (Fig 11)
