President Ann Covode called the meeting to order at 7:15pm.

Citizen Comments on Appropriation Ordinance and Levy

Ann Covode asked for any citizen comments; there were none. She summarized to those present that money allocated for Leider Park renovations is coming from various funds (totaling \$90,000). There is a new category for our After School Program entitled, "After School Program," rather than in previous versions of the ordinance where these funds came from the category of "Supplies." A donation has been made to Ridgeville Park District from the estate of Yvonne Vanden Avenue in the amount of \$65,795.17. It was expressed in her will to have this money go towards large trees and flowering shrubs in the parks, especially at Brummel Park. \$15,000 of that donation is in the budget for this year (\$10,000 for Brummel and \$5,000 for replacement trees at Ridgeville Park).
