



RIDGEVILLE PARK DISTRICT WILL HAVE THREE (3) SEATS VACANT ON THE BOARD FOR THE APRIL 2, 2019 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION

At that time, residents of Ridgeville Park District will elect **three commissioners** for a 6-year term. Park District elections are non-partisan, and candidates are nominated by petition. The 2019 Candidates Guide, which includes the necessary forms can be downloaded from the Illinois State Board of Election's web site www.elections.il.gov. The Ridgeville Park District and its secretary make no representations regarding the accuracy or validity of these forms. Be sure to consult with an attorney before taking action based upon these forms.

Each candidate must submit petitions containing signatures of qualified voters residing in the District equal in number of not less than 2% of the ballots cast in the last Park District election. For the consolidated election to be held on April 2nd of 2019, at least 94 qualified signatures will be required. Candidates are responsible for confirming the accuracy of this signature requirement with the Cook County Clerk's Office or an election attorney.

Candidates must live in Evanston within the Ridgeville Park District boundaries which are: South-Howard Street, North-Greenleaf Street (even numbered addresses), East-Chicago Northwestern railroad tracks, West North Shore Sanitation Canal.

Candidates' petitions must be filed in the district office after 9:00 A.M. starting December 10, 2018, and before 5:00 P.M. December 17, 2018.

The Park District is an independent government agency established in 1939 governed by five elected Commissioners. Regular monthly board meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month, at 7:30 PM in the Community House, 908 Seward Street, Evanston, IL 60202. Board members therefore have an opportunity to participate in the decisions, which determine park programs, recreational facilities, and the annual operating budget.
