A word from our New Activities Director

I wanted to take a moment to tell you a little bit about myself and my professional and educational experience, as well as share with you my philosophy and goals with respect to planning and implementing the Activity Programs at Bon Homie.

I have worked in the daycare, assisted living, and nursing home environments for a combined total of (over) 9 years. I have completed the MEPAP I and II courses (Modular Education Program for Activity Professionals) and I am preparing the paperwork needed to apply for my State Certification through NCCAP (National Certification Council for Activity Professionals). Upon acceptance, I will receive my credentials as an Activity Director Provisionally Certified (ADPC). This certification is earned by completing a year of courses. Among other criteria, applicants are required to have 14 college credits. one of which must be English Composition. To maintain your credentials, an Activity Director must complete 30 CEU's every 24 months. It's an ongoing learning process, but one that I am looking forward to and have found to be extremely rewarding.

The term "activity" means more to me than just "keeping clients busy." My motto is: "Activities are more than just fun and games ... it's a therapy." Recreation is a necessary component of EVERYONE'S life and is essential to the well being of ALL individuals, regardless of their physical, emotional, or mental condition. My goal is to provide recreational programs designed to engage our clients in social, cognitive, spiritual, physical, sensory stimulating, diversional, empowering, and creative-expressive activities that have personal meaning and purpose.

In the upcoming calendars you will notice some new programs, as well as past programs that we are revisiting and rebuilding. Some of the programs are: Horticulture Club, Weird Science, Nature Club, Cooking/Baking, Language (Spanish, French, and Sign), and monthly Birthday Parties.
