## **Before Competition:**

website.

## Day of Competition:

Coaches Check In will be held in a specific, marked location prior to the start of competition. \*\*Please note: there is NO COACHES MEETING\*\*. Therefore, it is extremely important that you check in early to receive all the updates and information you need. Plan to spend about 15 minutes checking in. Coaches can check in one hour before the start of competition.

At check in you will receive your final invoice, participant wristbands, gifts and any other important information necessary. Please be sure to turn in your signed medical release forms for your team at Check In.

Participants are responsible for all of their personal belongings before, during and after competition.

#### **General Traffic Flow & Procedures:**

Once registrations are finalized, you will receive by email the preliminary schedule of events. A general timeline will be sent before the schedule of events to assist you in making plans for your team.

The schedule indicates your reporting time, warm up time and performance time. Please report <u>on time</u> to the Coaches Check In area in the lobby. A staff member will assist you through the entire pre-performance circuit.

You may not have a walk through prior to competing, so please make sure to report ON TIME.

Warm up will be a part of the pre-performance circuit. Athletes will have access to a mat floor and stereo. A staff member will tell you when you can enter, and when your time is up.

During warm up we ask that you enter and exit quickly. If you are waiting to warm up next please stay clear of the warm up entrance out of respect for the team on the floor. Individuals, solos, partner stunts and group stunts will warm up in groups. Please ask your participants to be respectful and share the floor time.

#### Music:

Coaches are responsible for checking their music at the sound table anytime **prior to the start of competition.** 

### **Participant Conduct:**

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their participants. Any reports of unsportsmanlike behavior will be directed to the head coach.

## Judges & Scoring:

A panel of highly qualified judges from around the nation and state will be judging the competition. Scoresheets can be found online at <a href="https://www.topoftheworldcheer.com">www.topoftheworldcheer.com</a>. Please review them prior to competition.

#### Awards & Scoresheets:

Awards will begin within 15 minutes of the end of competition. Once the last team has exited the floor, the announcer will ask all participants to report to the competition floor. They should all still be in their uniform, costume or team wear. Awards will be given for each division.

## Please pick up your scoresheets at the DJ table following awards.

All decisions by the judges are final. If you find a tabulation error on your scoresheets, please contact Andrea Everett at 354-8852 following competition. We do not retain copies of the completed scoresheets.
