# Our Challenge – the Reality

- > Reduction in 2009-2010 State Aid \$811K
- Reduction in 2010-2011 State Aid \$1.71 Million
- ➤ UFRSD 2010-2011 school **budget cut** by **\$4.91 Million** to meet final estimates by UF Township and Allentown Borough

## Cuts were addressed by:

- ➤ Elimination of administrative, teaching, secretarial, paraprofessional, custodial, and security positions
- > Cutting extra-curricular activities, clubs, & school trips
- > Freezing or reducing necessary equipment and supplies purchases

# What have we done & how? \$49,000 awarded since 2007

#### **Fundraising:**

- Worked closely with community members for "Evening at the Arts" for the Music Program
- Partnered with MTFEE on "Fore the Kids" fundraiser (10/06)
- Comedy Night 2007 at Clarksburg Inn (6/07)
- Sno-Ball Softball Tournament (2/08, 2/09, 2/10)
- Night of Chance (3/08)
- UFREF Golf Outing (6/08)
- Community Twilight Challenge 5-K and Children's Fun Run (6/09, 6/10)
- STAR Awards Program (ongoing)

#### **Grants:**

- Formalized grant cycles in the spring and fall; managed via Grants Allocation Committee
- Awarded over \$49,000 in grants since 2007, across 43 approved requests covering all three schools.

#### Other:

 Bristol Myers Squibb grants AHS Robotics Club \$30,000 using UFREF as the grant receipt vehicle.
