‘Tea and Symphony’ (lit. meaning “sounding together”)

A new way of providing ongoing training in music subject knowledge for class teachers, which is low cost, locally based and supportive.

How it works

You – Provide the Tea

We – Provide the Symphony

A group of 8+ schools sign up to be a T and S group.

Herts Music Service provides a training session for **as many teachers as you like** from all the schools **once every half term**

Training is held in a host school which can be the same school every time or a different one in the group.

Because HMS have no premises costs we can keep the cost to school very low and charge on a **per school** not a per person basis.

We will arrange for skilled and experienced music specialists to come and lead the sessions, from 3.30- 5.30 or 4.00-6.00.

A training coordinator will liaise with all schools involved.

Participants will gain:

- confidence in participating in and teaching music
- repertoire and ideas which are tried and tested
- knowledge of how to plan for continuity and progression in music

Groups can sign up at the start of each financial year at a cost of £100 per school (2014-15)

For this you get **6 training sessions for as many teachers as you like!**
