AUTUMN NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

What if a house could talk.... For two days in November, the Victorian rooms of Highbury House will echo with voices of the past, revealing stories of love, heartbreak and courage at a time when the First World War changed lives forever. With an original script and songs Highbury Whispers tells the re-imagined story of the house through song, words and movement, created and performed by a team of fifty young people from North Hertfordshire. North Herts Music School and Goldfield Productions are proud to collaborate on this ambitious, ground-breaking, pilot project which enables young people from the area to create a

piece of theatre from scratch. Highbury House will be transformed with sound, lights and props into a site-specific sensory theatrical set utilising the original Victorian architecture. Audiences will promenade through the rooms, met by costumed choirs, ensembles, actors and percussion groups who reveal timeless stories and hidden secrets.

Whispers is created and delivered by a team of 50 young people (aged 11-17) drawn from NHMS (Saturday Morning Music School & established ensembles) and students at local secondary schools. Over a 5 month period, the young team have received mentoring, training and guidance from outstanding industry specialists enabling them create and deliver 6 public performances of Whispers, a 60 minute site-specific music-theatre production. To tie in with the anniversaries of the end of the WWI and with the Suffragette movement, the production will partner with North Herts Museum and Hitchin Library, where two 'pop-up' performances on Saturday 3rd November, which will give a taster of the show. North Herts Museum and Hitchin Library will both be hosting events during the half-term holiday to support Highbury Whispers. Please come along and get a hint of what the show will be about.

The Whispers project is led by dramaturge / director Caroline Clegg (Welsh National Opera, Feelgood Theatre), Kate Romano (Goldfield Productions), Nicky Footer (Head of North Herts Music School) and Nick Denham (Participation and Inclusion Officer for Hertfordshire Music Service). The children have also had many opportunities to attend workshops that teach them some of the skills needed to run a production, including prop and scenery-making workshop (Andy Lawrence) and a special make-up effects workshop run by an experienced artist. Here they learned all about colour-matching, prosthetic makeup and all about the makeup industry. Further mentors in lighting design (Georgie Ekers), Dance (Jane Turner), costume (Rachel Willis), all support the young team.

Eva Fuller (13) one of the producers, lead makeup artist and graphic designer said: 'This show gives us such amazing opportunities, I love working with great people and learning more about theatre'.

Lula Peacock (13) one of the writers, actress and a social media representative said: 'I came into Highbury Whispers only interested to perform but after meeting the production team, I decided that back stage would be just as fun. The show has taught me so much!'.

Nicky Footer (Head of North Herts Music School) said: 'This is such an exciting project for young people to be involved in. They have taken on the full responsibility of all that is involved in a theatre production; they have been mentored by professionals and many will gain their Arts Award'.

Kate Romano (Artistic Director, Goldfield Productions) said: Young people are naturals when it comes to site-specific theatre; it's like play. Giving them the creative freedom to tell stories in their own way yields astonishing results; they collaborate, they find their voices, everyone is part of the team and the results are fantastic'.
