2. **Participant Eco-Shops** – The remaining 2 hours will allow each participant to present a concise problem, issue, or project that they face. 1-2 minutes will be allowed to set up the situation and 8 minutes for experts and all participants to offer advice and guidance.

The topic you submit **in advance** will be compiled and edited to be concise and diverse. You are encouraged to bring in plans, photos, recipes, etc., or submit them in advance. The more information submitted in advance, and *the more concise your question*, the better we will be able to address your problem. Topic suggestions include:

- With a site plan, how can I best lay out a garden?
- How do I go about sun drying a particular crop?
- Tips and tricks for growing .... organically
- What can I do with a bumper crop of ....?
