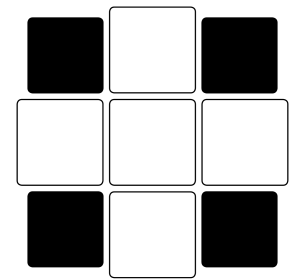


# We Must Dwell in Community

3. How do we experience closeness with God? [true heart, full assurance, bodies washed] Does this describe you?
4. What does it mean to “hold fast?” [to persevere in faith] What is required to hold fast? [a strong and growing theology]
5. What does it mean to “stir up?” [to provoke or incite] What does stirring up require? [heart and hands; belief and behavior]
6. When it comes to the “how tos” of stirring up (scripture, relationships, words, church, and effort) how are you doing with each?
