

Safe Environment Training

In order to volunteer at St. Theresa Parish you are required to annually participate in Safe Environment Training referred to as SET. It is mandatory that ALL ADULT VOLUNTEERS (18 years of age and older) participate annually in SET following requirements established by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Phoenix.

SET Foundation Training

The SET Foundation Training Program “Protecting God's Children for Adults”, is offered only in group sessions requiring in person attendance, completion of a volunteer application and acknowledgment and signature of the diocese “Code of Ethics”. This training is for those who have never taken any SET training before.

SET Renewal

Once you have completed SET Foundation Training, subsequent years can be completed online; this is referred to as SET Renewal. We encourage you to complete the present year's SET Renewal session. SET Renewal is available for each new fiscal year starting July 1st.

To complete an online SET Renewal, follow the steps below:

1. Go to the SET website at www.safeenvironmenttraining.org.
2. Click on “Online Renewal” or “My Obligations”
3. Enter your first and last name and street address ONLY and click “search”. If your address has changed you may need to input your old address first before you update it in the database.
4. Now check for accuracy to the data and update your contact information if necessary. Then click “Update Information and Continue”.

5. Select an Online Renewal Class, preferably the present year's renewal which will log you into the course directly. **2015's Renewal is "Celebrating and Protecting the gift of life 2015"**.

6. Please make certain you wait until the session states you have completed your annual renewal. If you leave the session early you will not get credit for compliance. An email notification should follow shortly thereafter from the SET Database Administrator confirming compliance.
