

Infant Feeding (required for children under 12 months)

The choice of which infant formula and/or breast milk to feed your child is your decision, in consultation with your child's physician.

New Gulph Children's Center participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). New Gulph provides one (1) kind of infant formula to children under the age of twelve months. Our "formula of choice" is Enfamil Premium (yellow top – powder). Formula is prepared by the Infant/Toddler teachers in bottles (with nipples) provided by the parent. The \$6.00 daily food fee covers the cost of the formula.

Parents may elect to decline the use of Enfamil Premium and supply their own preferred formula or breast milk.

To comply with CACFP regulations, New Gulph must retain a record of your decision regarding infant formula. Please complete the information below and return it to the office.
