WINDCHIMES

Boats moored in the harbor, please help us out. The sound of a distant halyard plinking in the breeze might sound like nice therapy. 49 halyards clanging all night long more closely resembles a 5th grade band concert. Please find a way to secure your halyards so they are not pulled tight against your mast.

You can find a place on your stem fitting or bow pulpit to attach them to.

Use your main halyard to hold up the boom. Attach a bungee cord between the halyard and the side-stay to hold the line away from the boom. Thank You.
