Please bail the water from the boats. DO-NOT Pull the boats up onto the dock and overturn them. This puts a ton of stress on the "keel" of the boats and eventually causes leaks.

Please remove the oars from the oar locks when putting the boats away.

Please hang onto heavy duty gallon size bottles that can be used for balers. For some reason these walk off with amazing frequency.
