MOORING/SPLICING CLINIC

Does your mooring pendant look like the picture in the Member Handbook, or are you still a little shaky on how to splice that loop? One boat that breaks loose of its mooring can put all the boats in the harbor in jeopardy! There are premade mooring pendants out there, but if you are feeling adventurous and want to splice your own (or splice for some other project), now is the time to learn! Mike Klinkner will be conducting a splicing clinic at the Swap Meet from 11:00 AM-12:00 PM. (RSVP required) He will provide the tools needed to splice and you just need to bring the materials necessary for your particular mooring pendant needs. Not sure how long your line needs to be? Not sure where to buy the line or thimble? Tip: Krueger's True Value has ½"swivels for \$20. Thimbles and line can be bought at Krueger's or Fleet Farm. 
however due to weather and low attendance at last years lift in on opening day this years has been
