### SUMMER SAILSTICE - 6/21

Join Neenah-Nodaway Yacht Club for a sailing cruise and raft-up on Lake Winnebago, starting at 2:00 p.m. - open to the public. If you have a boat, Sail to a buoy that will be anchored off the Rec Park boat ramp in Neenah, 600 S. Park Ave. The buoy will be anchored at approx. 44.177 latitude - 88.433 longitude. A compass bearing will be marked on the buoy as the location of the raft up. Boats can meet at the buoy at 2:00 and sail together, or follow along at their own pace. The raft-up location will be a safe anchorage on the Northern end of Lake Winnebago. Bring some snacks and drinks for yourselves, and enough to share if you would like.
