PFD REMINDER

Notice to all members using harbor dinghies: You must provide a wearable PFD (personal floatation device) for each person in a club-owned or personal dinghy. DNR wardens patrol the harbor front and will cite if you fail to carry or wear adequate PFDs while operating the dinghies. If you have a child with you, they must wear a PFD that is appropriate for their weight. If you need additional PFDs for visitors, the DNR provides loaner PFDs in a box at Rec Park in both adult and children sizes.
