WEED CUTTING- SCHEDULE CHANGE!

We are asking all boat owners in the harbor (not hospital) to assist us by moving their boats to the Riverside Park sea wall between **5:00 PM Tuesday July 15 and 9:00 AM Wednesday, July 16**. You can leave your boat on the wall after racing Tuesday. We will be rafting the boats off the wall, and we are requesting that you put out fenders on the starboard side of your boat, and secure your boat with a bow and stern dock line. If you have extra fenders, please put them out as well. We can move your boat to the wall for you but appreciate it if you can do it or can make arrangements. NNYC will return boats to the moorings after the work is done. If you wish to return your boat to its mooring please contact commodore@nnyc.org.

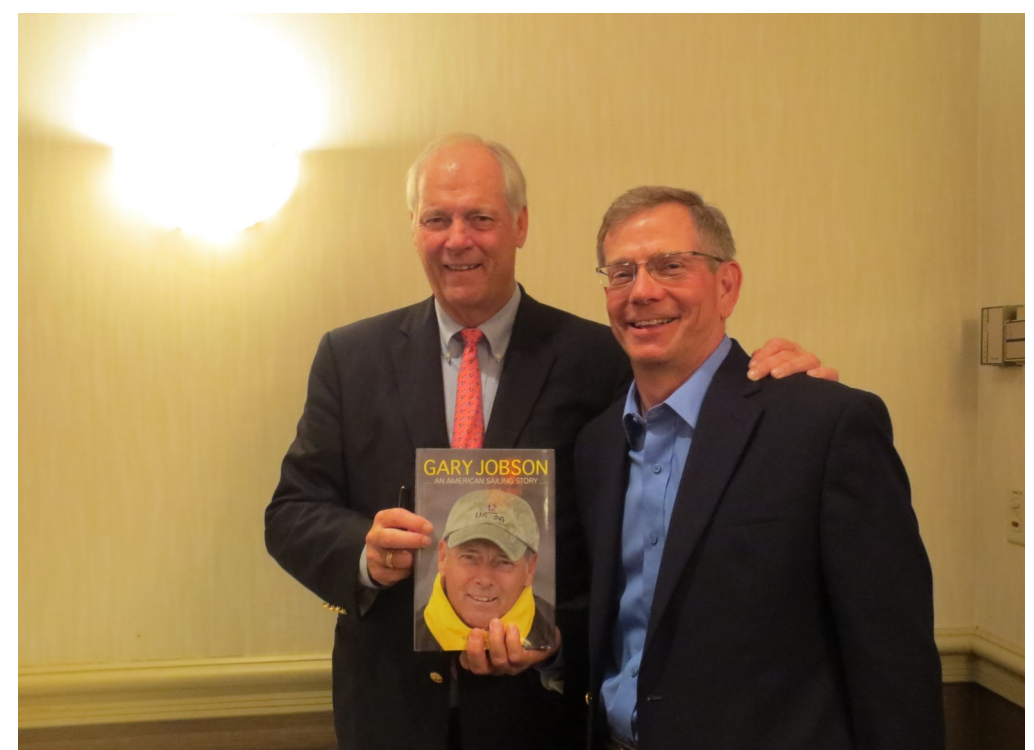

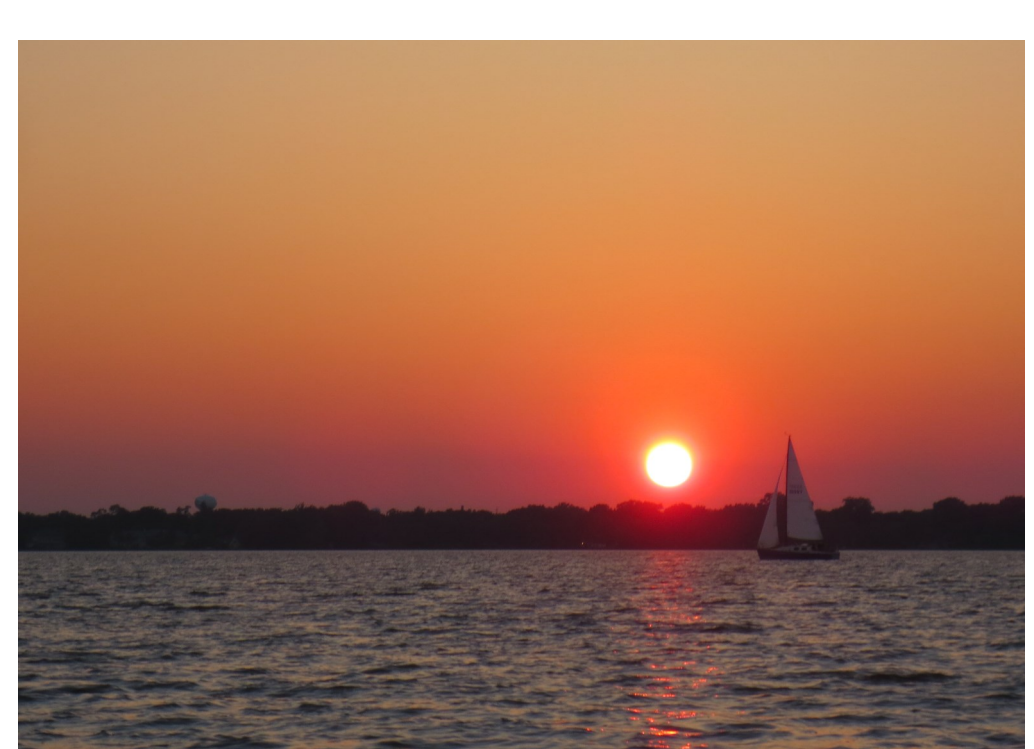
