NNYC BURGEE AROUND THE WORLD

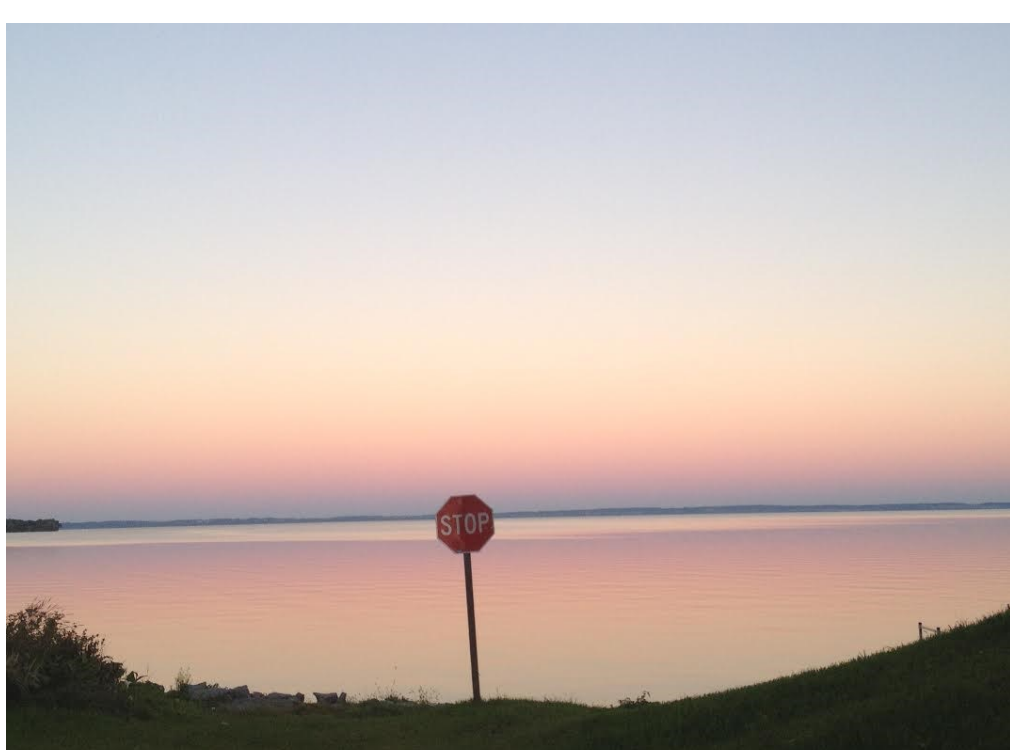
