RULE CHANGE

Rule 9.4 of our Sailing Instructions will be changed to reflect that the finish line for Tuesday night racing will remain identical to the starting line. That will mean that at the finish, the race committee boat will be at the port and the buoy at the starboard end of the finish line. Unless otherwise published, this change will be in effect the entire 2015 season. The rationale for the change is twofold. It will reduce the burden on the committee boat and crew, and it will reduce time between races on two race nights.
