### NNYC MATCH RACING

NNYC is pleased to announce that it will hold its first informal **Match Race competition on Sunday August 9.** We will have on-lake practice sessions in the morning and round-robin races in the afternoon. Lunch will be provided. There will be a \$20 fee for the event, which should cover the cost of lunch, trophies or the like and prizes for participation.

Any one-design boats may compete as long as there are two or more competitors. The idea for this race started with the Flying Scot fleet. If you want to join the Flying Scot round-robin, you can rent a scot from the sailing school.

**Our goal is to have fun and socialize** while maneuvering other boats away from the starting line and watching ourselves and our friends make mistakes **while trying to learn something new.**

**Mark Johnson will be on the water to give coaching advice.** That should be interesting as he will be giving advice simultaneously to two competitors in a win-lose race.

Two things to remember. Match races are shorter and buoys are rounded to starboard.

But Wait...there is more! **Mark Johnson has agreed to give a short seminar on match racing sometime before the event.** We are thinking that we could meet after Flying Scot racing on 8-5-15 for pizza and his presentation. That is a tentative date, so watch for further news.
