### TRI-SAIL-ATHON CUP RACE

The Tri-Sail-Athon is a new fun race combining a bicycle sprint, a kayak race and a Flying Scot sailboat mini regatta into a three-legged mashup sponsored by the Neenah-Nodaway Yacht Club (NNYC), High Cliff Yacht Club (HCYC), Fox Valley Sailing School (FVSS) and participating business and non-profit organizations.

Anyone from NNYC, HCYC, or FVSS can form a team. Each team needs three members: one cyclist, one kayaker and one sailor. Each leg of the race will last 45 to 90 minutes. Flying Scot captains must be NNYC or HCYC members or FVSS instructors. All three team members must be on board for the sailing leg.

Teams must provide their own bicycles and kayaks and all safety equipment. NNYC and FVSS will provide Flying Scot sailboats as needed.

Don't know a cyclist or a kayaker? We will help you make connections with cyclists from CRANKED and/or kayakers from the North East Wisconsin Paddlers Association.

The top three finishers in each sport and overall will receive recognition prizes. All participants will be eligible for a gag gift raffle held at the Awards Ceremony and Social following the Tri-Sail-Athon.
