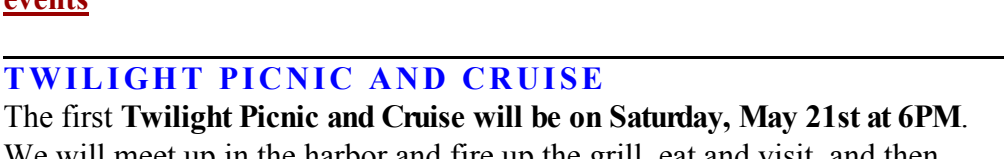

### DRAGONFORCE 65 R/C SAILING

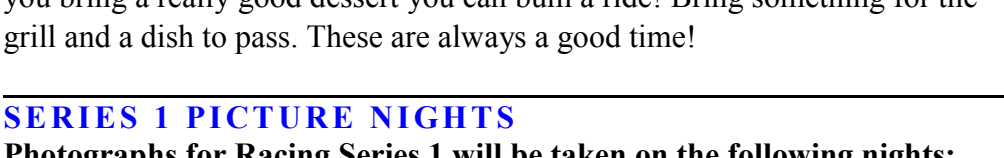
**Schedule for May:**
