BOAT DECK CLEANING DAY

To keep the *Nodaway* and *Lakefly* looking good we would like to establish the pattern of cleaning the decks in the fall and the bottoms in the spring. We were able to clean the hulls during harbor opening day so I am looking for volunteers for **Saturday morning September 17th** to clean the decks. DINGHY RECONDITIONING VOLUNTEERS WANTED

The dinghies are vital to our mooring field operation and like any equipment at time they need some upkeep. During harbor opening and closing we do minor repairs yet at times a dinghy requires an overhaul. We currently have one dinghy that needs reconditioning to stop it from leaking. The first step in the process is to clean the bottom down to the metal. This involves sanding off the scale that has built up over the years until you are almost to the aluminum and then using hull clearer to take off the final layer. This is a time consuming task so we are looking for volunteers to help out. The dinghy is staged at the harbor and supplies will be available in the wash pump bin so you can volunteer on your own schedule. **If can pitch in please contact Rob Bryson at vicecommodore@nnyc.org**
