### DINGHY RECONDITIONING VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The dinghies are vital to our mooring field operation and like any equipment at time they need some upkeep. During harbor opening and closing we do minor repairs yet at times a dinghy requires an overhaul. We currently have one dinghy that needs reconditioning to stop it from leaking. The first step in the process is to clean the bottom down to the metal. This involves sanding off the scale that has built up over the years until you are almost to the aluminum and then using hull clearer to take off the final layer. This is a time consuming task so we are looking for volunteers to help out.
