FADE IN:

ACT ONE

EXT. DOCKS - DAY

Matthew and Jack stand with serious expressions on their faces. Matthew looks tired, weary.

JACK

The Windigo is back, more powerful
than ever. Matthew... You're going
to have to take him out.
Wîndigo kokî tagoshin, kinawe kaye mashkawizî.
Matthew... Mâmakâdj ke-jâgodinadj.

MATTHEW

What will it take to beat him?
Awegonen ked-âbadjitôyengoban kidji-
jâgodineng? *

Jack looks away from Matthew.

JACK

I'm more worried about whether or
not you're capable of doing what
needs to be done.
K i n a w e k i n ô d j â n i m e n i m i n

Kagagi raises an eyebrow.

INT. THE ASTRO CAFE - DAY

Tommy and Cassie are seated at a table. Tommy still looks quite shaken up.

CASSIE

Are you sure you're okay? Knockout
gas and data theft? That's a lot to
take.
Kidebwe na minwâyân? Kâ-ijwebak mâmawe pôtâganâbo
ashidj kichi-gikenindamâwin kâ-gimôdinâniwang. *

TOMMY

(shaking, nervously)
I'm fine. Really.
N i m i n w â y â . K a g e t i n â m . *

CASSIE

Maybe you should to talk to
someone. You trust me, right?
Konima âwiyeg kanôndiban. Kidapenimonâj
na, kegetinâm? *

TOMMY

Of course. I just wonder...
Enh, enh. Ayî eta
nimidonenindân...

CASSIE

Wonder what?

Awegonen medonenindaman?

TOMMY

We're just a couple of high school
kids. No one's gonna believe
anything we say.

CASSIE

ondamitâyân. Tagawas nânâge tajindâda iyo, keget na?

Tommy's lost in thought.

TOMMY

Where's Matt?
Ândî Matt?

*
*

Tommy is quiet, looking down at the table.

CASSIE

Alright?
Ânh, keget igodj. *

He nods in affirmation.

*

EXT. DOCKS - NIGHT

Matthew and Jack stand, Matthew looks even more tired than
last time.

MATTHEW

Okay, well with Windy back, I
better get on patrol--
*Anh, mî `sa minawâdj Windy kî-dagoshing, mâmakâdj
ked-awi-babâ-andawâbiyân...

Matthew yawns. Jack raises an eyebrow.

JACK

Kid? You okay?
Abinodjînsh? Kego na kidind?

MATTHEW

Just tired. Juggling two lives is
taking a lot out of me. I haven't
been sleeping much lately.
Nidayekoz eta. Nîj pimâdiziwinan taji-
memeshkodôbidôyân kenwek igodj âjaye nibimi-
nisidamandjitôn. Kabehî kê'n kwech ninibâsî.

*
*

Jack nods.

JACK

I can patrol tonight. You go home,
get some rest. You're no good to
anyone in this condition. Here...
Nidâ-baba-anda-wâb onâgoshig. Mâdjâ kîwen, awi-anwebin. Kâ'n poch
kidonishishisî ondje kodag âwiweg. Ne... odâpinan awaso.*

*

* Take this.

Jack hands him a dreamcatcher.

MATTHEW

A dreamcatcher?
Wejibâbandasab?

Jack CHUCKLES.

JACK

Hang it in your window when you get
home. It'll help with the sleep.
Agôdôn kidônzâbwâganing apîch kî-dagoshinan endân.
Kiga-wîdôkâgon nibâyen.*

*

Matthew gives Jack a look.

JACK (CONT'D)

Humor me! Now, go on, get moving. I
got work to do.
*Pâpinokâjishin! Mâdjâ tash, ani-mâdjân. Nidayân
ondamitâwin.

*

Matthew yawns, stretches and leans back against a box.

MATTHEW

Be careful tonight, Jack.
Ayângwâmîn onâgoshig, jack.*

Matthew is out of there in a flash.

*

JACK'S POV:

*

The dreamcatcher he'd given Matthew sits on top of the box.

*

JACK

Come on, kid.
Ondâs, abinôdjînsh.*

Jack grabs the dreamcatcher and stuffs it into his pocket. *

INT. MATTHEW'S HOUSE - KITCHEN - NIGHT *

Janet sits at the kitchen table, reading a book. Matthew enters, startling her. *

JANET

You're home early.
Wîbadj kibî-gîwe.*

MATTHEW

I'm wiped out, Kokom.
Nigitângogaje ayekoz, kôkôm.*

Janet nods, looking concerned.

JANET

Matty, please don't take this the wrong way, but I hope you aren't heading down the wrong path. *
Matty, enâbigis kê'n napâdji-odâpiniyegen iyo, anishâ tash kegona `sa ega madji-mîkanâng ijâyen.*

MATTHEW

I'm really tired, that's all. *
Just... Give me a break.
Nigitângogaje ayekoz, mî igodj eta iye. Eta igodj. Pagidâbîginishin.

He turns to walk away. *

MATTHEW (CONT'D)

I'm going to bed. You can finish chewing me out later.
Nidawi-gawishim. Kidâ-ishkwâ-jâshâgom nânâge.*

He SLAMS the kitchen door on his way out. Janet SIGHS. *

JANET.

What am I going to do with you?
Ânîn âpidje ke-dôdônân?*

INT. MUSEUM OF HISTORY - ANCIENT ROME EXHIBIT ROOM - NIGHT *

Cassie dusts an exhibit as Mr. Keeper passes by, catching her eye. *

CASSIE

Oh - Mr. Keeper! Just the person I'm looking for. *
Oh - Kinawenindjigewininî ! Mî igodj iya enda-wâbamag.*

MR. KEEPER

Yes, Cassandra?

Awegonen, Cassandra?

CASSIE

I've got the South Wing ready for the new pieces and I'm nearly done cleaning.

Kakina Ojâwanông inakâg nigî-wawenisidôn ondje inen oshki-ayîn ashidj âjaye kegâd nidishkwâ-bînichige.

Mr. Keeper nods and begins inspecting her work on the exhibit.

*

CASSIE (CONT'D)

But I was wondering if we had any more special wipes for the glass cases. I ran out earlier and I don't have a key for the storage closet--

*

*

Anisha tash niwî-gikenindam kîshpin kidji-ayâmowanen kâsiniganensan ondje inen ozâbowâganâbiko-atâganan. Nigî-djâginânan nôngom ashidj kâ'n nidyâsîn âbiwinân ondje iye atâsowin --

Mr. Keeper straightens and turns sharply.

MR. KEEPER

I see.

Iyena.

He hands her the keys.

*

CLOSE-UP:

*

The golden key dangles from the key-ring, the engraved torch glistening in the light.

*

*

But he retracts his hand, quickly.

MR. KEEPER (CONT'D)

*

I almost forgot. We ran out. I'll get some tomorrow.

*

K e g â d n i g î - w a n î k e . K i g î -
d j â g i s e m i n . N i g a - n â d i n a n
w â b a n g . *

As Mr. Keeper walks away, stops and eyes her suspiciously, then carries on.

*

*

CASSIE

I've gotta get in that room.

Mâmakâdj ke-bîndigeyân 'indaje pakesâyâng. *

Cassie's cell phone RINGS. She answers it.

*

CASSIE (CONT'D)

*

Tommy! I've got something for you.

Tommy! K e g o n n i d a y â n o n d j e k î n . *

INTERCUT WITH:

*

INT. TOMMY'S HOUSE - TOMMY'S ROOM - NIGHT

He sulks on his bed, clutching a shoe box to himself.

TOMMY (PHONE)

Cassie. Listen, I'll swing by
later. I have something to give
you.

Cassie. Pizindan, niga-binôngibiz nânâge. Kego
nidayân ke-mîninân.

Cassie looks puzzled.

CASSIE

What?
Awegonen?

TOMMY

It's important.
Kichi-apîtenindâgwad.

INT. MATTHEW AND JANET'S HOUSE - MATTHEW'S ROOM - NIGHT

Matthew lies on top his bed, sleeping. He MURMURS, tosses and
turns, having a bad dream.

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

Kagagi stands in the training ground area. The sky is
multicolored. He examines his surroundings.

KAGAGI

What's going on?
Ânîn ejiwebak?

He looks up and around.

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

Nigig? Jack? Any more giant bats to
watch out for?
Nigig? Jack? Kiyâbadj na taniziwag kichi-
bâgwânâdjînshag ked-akamawagwâban?*

JANET (O.S.)

Now grandson, why would you think
that?
Wah tagana nidôshis, awegonen ke-ondji-inenindaman
iye?

Kagagi whirls, shocked. He sees Janet; her eyes are bright
red like Windigo's.

JANET (CONT'D)

There's nothing crazy about this
place. Everything here makes
perfect sense.

K â ' n o n d a j e k e g o
k î w a n â d e n i n d â g o s i n ô n . K a k i n a
k e g o ' o n d a j e m i n o b i d e . *

Kagagi looks confused.

KAGAGI

Kokom! No! How do you know who I
am? You, you can't possibly--

Kôkôm! Kâwin! Ânîn eji-gikenimin nîn
âwiyân? Kîn, kâ'n kone ki --*

Janet smiles, creepily.

JANET

How disappointing that you would be
ashamed of your true self. You'll
never cease to let me down.

Kichi-mindâdenindâgwad agadjitôn tibinawe
eyâwiyen. Kâ'n wîkâd kidâ-bagidenimisî.*

KAGAGI

Kokom, this isn't you.

Kôkôm, kâwin kîn kidâwisî.*

Janet shakes her head, hands on hips in an exaggerated
manner, she shakes her finger at him.

JANET

After all that I've done for you -
this is the thanks I get! You
ungrateful little brat!

Kakina kâ-bi-inanokîyân ondje kîn - mî awaso
eji-mîgwechiwîyen! Mâdjân madjitwâns ega
kinagena mayâmôyâwagenindaman.*

KAGAGI

I'm so sorry!

Kâ'n nigodinenimishiken!

Janet smiles and disappears out of existence, as familiar
Windigo LAUGHTER booms across the dreamscape.

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

Windigo? This is a dream. You're
not real.

W î n d i g o ? W e j i b â b a n d a m o w i n i y o .
K â w i n k e g e t i n â m k î n . *

The Windigo materializes before him; smiling menacingly.

WINDIGO

I assure you, I am all too real. I
took something very valuable from
your little friend, Nigig.
Kegetinâm `sa igodj, nîn igodj
iyo. Kego nigî-odâpinamowâ kechi-
apîtenindâgwak kiwîdjikiwens,
Nigig.

*

Kagagi looks worried.

KAGAGI

Nigig's powers let you invade my
dreams? You don't know who I am.
Nigig omashkawizîwin kigîbagidinigon kidji-gagandji-
bîndigen niwejibâbandjiganing? Kâwin kigîkenimisî
awenîn eyâwiyân. *

Kagagi laughs.

WINDIGO

(increasingly angrier)
That's because they're protecting
you!
Mî mega kinâgadawâbamigog!*

*

*

KAGAGI

I'll never let you win.
Kâwin wîkâd kiga-bagidinisinôn kidji-bakinwâgen.*

Janet appears again. She smiles cruelly, as the Windigo nods
and laughs.

*

JANET

No matter the cost?
Ânîdog igodj ked-apîtenindâgwadogwen?*

EXT. RANDOM ROOFTOP - NIGHT

*

Jack walks with Nigig atop a building.

NIGIG

You're on patrol, aren't you?
Kibaba-akando, keget na?*

JACK

Busted. The kid is burnt out.
* Someone's gotta do it.
Kimishishâwaganebij. Abinôdjînsh kichi-ayekoze.
Mâmakâdjâwiyeg ked-inanokîdj.*

Nigig steps in front of him, angrily.

NIGIG

Jack, I can't be here. It's not
safe for me
Jack, kâ'n nidâ-danizisînâban `ondaje. Kâwin
sôngenindâgosinôn `ondaje ondje nîn.

*

JACK

Nigig, what are you talking about?
We've been doing this for
centuries! We fight monsters, we
deal with it.

Nigig, awegonen endajindaman? Kigî-bi-inanokîmin
kichi-ayândasin mitâchin mitasomidana taso pibôn!
Kimîgânânig kichi-gagwetâdjichiganag,
kiwawejitônânân.*

NIGIG

What use am I without my powers?
I've been reduced to... Nothing.
Ânîn enâbadjiziyân ega mâmawe nimashkawizîwin? Nigî-
nâjinigo ako... kân kego nidayâsîn.

JACK

Old friend, your power comes from
within. We need your help.
Kete wîdjikiwe, kimashkawizîwin onzikâ pindj
wîyawing. Nidandawenindânânân kiwîdôkâzowin.*

Nigig stares at his feet.

NIGIG

What help? I've never felt so
helpless.
*Awegonen wîdôkâzowininan? Kâ'n wîkâd
nidinamandjiwosî kidji-iji-wawânitôyân tash kaye
nôngom.

EXT. MUSEUM OF HISTORY - ENTRANCE - NIGHT

Cassie is leaving the Museum. She holds the door open and
YELLS in before closing it.

CASSIE

Good night, Mr. Keeper.
Mino-nibâ, Kinawenindjigewininî.*

Cassie shuts the door and walks off, looking a bit perturbed.
She looks up and sees Tommy, carrying a backpack.

CASSIE (CONT'D)

You really are punctual, aren't
you!
Kigichi-gâgige minwâpîch kidagoshin, keget ina?

He smiles weakly.

CASSIE (CONT'D)

**Come on, Tommy... Cheer up. I hate
seeing you so down.**
Ah, Tommy.. Môdjigizin. Kâ'n niminwenindazî wâbiminân
nanegâdenindaman.

Tommy hands her the bag.

She takes the backpack and CHUCKLES before looking inside.

CASSIE (CONT'D)

If you think I'm going to do your homework, Wetzal-- Is... This what I think it is?

Kîshpin enenindamiwanen kidji-ojitôyân kigikinâmâgo-ondamitâwin, Wetzal - Mî na ... Awaso pâkwâ enenindmân?

She extracts a CD marked "Weirdfiles data."

TOMMY

It's yours. I'm done.
Kîn tibenindan. Nidishkwâtâ nîn.*

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING AREA - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

Janet stands over Kagagi, who is down on his knees, doubled over, shielding his ears. The Windigo leers, enjoying this.

JANET

You continue to pursue a destiny that will destroy you! You don't care that you are all I have left, do you?
Kiyâbadj kinôswadôn enenindâgozin ke-nishawinâdjîgoyen! Kâ'n kinagena kimidonenindazî kîn eta âjaye ayâwinân.

KAGAGI

Kokom, please stop, I don't know what you want me to say!
Kôkôm, enâbigis pônitân, kâ'n nigîkenindazîn endawenimin kidji-ikidoyân.

JANET

You will abandon me. Just like everyone else has. And I'm supposed to feel sorry for you?
Kiga-nagaj. Maya igodj kakina âwiyeg kê-dôdawidj. Mâmakâdj tash ke-gidimâgeniminân?

KAGAGI

No. No...
Kâ. Kâwin...

JANET

Maybe I should have left you, when your parents died?
Konima kî-naganinâmbân, apîch kê-nibôwâdj kinîgîgog?
Kagagi hears this and clenches his fists before, opening his eyes, standing.

KAGAGI

This isn't you, Kokom.
Kâ'n kîn kidâwisî, Kôkôm.*

There is a burst of energy as Janet disappears. Kagagi takes a step back before turning to Windigo.

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

You've gone too far. I will get you
for this. No matter what you throw
at me!
Ozâm âjaye kigî-jemâgibiz. Kiga-godamandjitôyîn
ondje iyo. Awegodogwendog igodj wâ-
babîmâtigwâjiwanen?*

The Windigo LAUGHS.

WINDIGO

The night has just begun!
Pidjînag kimâdji-dibikad!

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

EXT. RANDOM ROOFTOP - NIGHT

Jack and Nigig stand looking out at the city.

JACK

It seems so quiet.
Kichi-banagate enenindâgwak.

NIGIG

Yes, but there's always something
going on beneath the surface. You
just need to know where to look.
Enh enh, anisha tash igodj wîn
kâgige kegon mâdjîshkâ anâmehî.
Mâmakâdj eta ke-gikenindaman ândî
maya ked-inâbiyen.

Nigig BREATHES in, deeply, awaiting a response. When none comes, he looks around. Jack is nowhere to be seen.

NIGIG (CONT'D)

Jack?

Nigig takes a walk around the rooftop. He stops and shakes his head.

NIGIG (CONT'D)

Jack, if this is some sort of trick-
- A game, I have no patience for-
Jack, kîshpin megonâdiziwinen -
- Odaminowin, kâ'n nideji-bekâdjideyesîondje iyo.

KAGAGI: THE RAVEN
Suddenly, a CREAK.

NIGHT TERRORS

13.

A beat.

Then, another CREAK and LAUGHTER.

NIGIG (CONT'D)

Jack?

(pause)

Who is that? Who's there?

Awenîn tash kîn? Awenîn endanizidj?*

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING AREA - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

The Windigo hovers before a very angry Kagagi, smiling.

Kagagi leaps at him, and in a flash, the Windigo disappears.
Kagagi lands hard on the dirt and rises, turning, he sees not
the Windigo, but Nigig... With glowing red eyes.

NIGIG

Surprised to see me?

Kigoshkohîn na wâbamin?

KAGAGI

You're not really Nigig.

Kâwin poch kinigigiwisî.

Nigig LAUGHS at him, in an exaggerated manner, SLAPPING his
knee.

NIGIG

Oh, boy! You know, it's funny,
people say you aren't living up to
your potential. Maybe, *maybe* they
just overestimated your potential.

Oh, kîwisens! Kigîkenindân na, wîyajitâgwad,
pemâdizidjig ikidowag ega kwech kashkitôn eji-
gashkitôyamban iko. Konima, konima kigî-ozâm
odâpinigômîdok.

KAGAGI

More games! Clever, Windy.

Kodagan odaminôwinan! Kagîtâze, Windy.

NIGIG

It's not your fault, Kagagi. You
just aren't the hero they say you
are. No shame in it.

Kâ'n kîn kidindiwin, Kâgâgî. Ka'n kinagena
kidapîtenimigôsî tash egôn.

KAGAGI

Be quiet!

Wâge

abin!

Just some scared, pathetic kid.

Eta igodj sayegizidj, kidimâgâdj abinôdjînsh.

KAGAGI

Look, whatever you are... Shut up!

Ne, awegweniwanen... Kîshkwen! *

NIGIG

That's it, isn't it? You are just a scared kid!

Mî iye, keget na? Eta igodj

kidâbinôdjînshîw kê-zegizidj towa.

Kagagi turns and clenches his fists.

KAGAGI

I'm *not* scared!

Kâ'n nizegizisî!

*

Nigig looks down for a moment, silent. After a beat, he looks up, smiling in a menacing, creepy manner.

NIGIG

You *should* be!

Kidâgî `sa!

*

Kagagi recoils as Nigig leaps at him!

*

EXT. RANDOM ROOFTOP - NIGHT

*

Nigig backs away slowly, walking along the edge of the rooftop for an escape route.

NIGIG

I don't know who you are but... I'm warning you... You don't want a piece of this.

K â ' n k i g î k e n i m i s i n ô n

a w e g w e n i w a n e n a n i s h a t a s h . . .

k i d i n i n k i d j i - a y â n g w â m î n . . .

K â ' n a w a s o

k i d a n d a w e n i n d a z î n . *

*

*

From the shadows, two minions emerge.

*

MINION 1

Oh. He's little.

Oh, agâshînshe.

MINION 2

Little as minions!

Agâshînshe mays igodj abanîg!

MINION 1

Can we keep him?

Kidâ-ganawenimânân na?

MINION 2

You always break your stuff!
Kâgige kibîgotôn kego ayâman!

At this point, Nigig turns and runs.

MINION 1

Get him!
Nawadin!

The minions fly off after the fleeing Nigig!

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

Kagagi ducks and dodges the evil Nigig's manic attacks. He isn't really trying to fight Nigig... As if he's not sure what's real and what isn't.

KAGAGI

Stop it!
Pônitân!

Evil Nigig sticks a tongue out at Kagagi, petulantly. His eyes glow a fierce red.

NIGIG

Stop talking and fight me!
Pônitân ânimitâgozin, mîgâjishin!

Kagagi ROARS as he throws a punch at dream Nigig.

KAGAGI

Enough!
Tibise!

The punch passes right through Dream Nigig who bursts, in a flash of light as the fake Janet had.

Kagagi falls forward and lands on his knees. He hangs his head for a moment, looking up slowly as we see the Windigo hovering behind him.

WINDIGO

Well, well, well. It looks like you
have—
Mî `sa, mî `sa, mî `sa. Kodinesh igodj ejinâgozin
ayâman --

Another burst of light.

A brown boot steps in front of Kagagi.

He looks up to see Jack, with glowing red eyes, shaking his head at him, woefully.

JACK

... A problem with authority.
... madjibizowin māmawe nîgânizîg.

Evil Jack reaches into his pouch and extracts something... In his hand, a red fireball! *

EXT. STREET - SIDEWALK - NIGHT *

Tommy and Cassie walk. *

CASSIE

Tommy... I don't know what to say.
Tommy... Kâwin nigikenindazîn ked-ikidoyâmbân.

TOMMY

I want you to burn it.
Kidandawenimin kidji-ishkwâziman. *

She shakes her head. *

TOMMY (CONT'D)

Look, I was going to do it myself,
but I figured--
Ne, nidinwâzinâban tibinawe kidji-inanokîyân, nigî-
inenindam tash -- *

CASSIE

You figured I might stop you,
didn't you?
Kigî-inenindam kidji-nôngininân, keget na? *

Tommy pauses.

TOMMY

No... I mean-- All of this, it's
dangerous. We could get hurt...
What's worse is, our loved ones
could get hurt.
K â w i n . . . W â - i k i d o y â n - K a k i n a
a w a s o , n a n î z â n ' e . K i d â -
w î s i g â p i n e m i n . . . K i n a w e t a s h
' e s e y â g i y a n g i n d w â t â -
w î s i g â p i n e g . *

He turns and walks away. *

CASSIE

Tommy, wait.
Tommy, pîwon. *

TOMMY

What is it, Cass?
Aweonen Cass? *

A beat. *

CASSIE

I have something to show you...

Just hear me out.

Kego kiwî-wâbandahiyîn. Pizindawishin.

EXT. RANDOM ROOFTOP - NIGHT

Nigig runs across the rooftop at top speed and leaps from the one he's on, to the next. He almost doesn't make it, pulling himself up, he clammers onto the building.

The minions pursue him. A third minion appears in the sky.

NIGIG

What do you want from me?

Awegonen endanwenindaman?

MINION 3

More minions!

Kinawe nîbina abanîg!

The other two practically jump out of their skin! Minion 1 shoves Minion 3, peeved.

MINION 1

Stupid minion! You scared me!

Pizinâdizî abanîwish! Kigî-zegihî!

MINION 3

Minion sorry.

Abani nanegâdenindam.*

The minions CHATTER amongst one another.

CLOSE-UP:

Nigig hides behind a chimney, looking on... Eyebrow raised.

NIGIG

(to himself)

So... You guys scare easy, huh?

Mî tash... Kinawe kinaye-zegizim, huh?

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

Kagagi and Evil Jack hover in midair, locked in combat. Kagagi is throwing shots, firing energy discs at Jack! Jack ducks an energy attack.

JACK

Clearly, you just don't have what it takes, kid.

Kikenindâgwad, ega ayâman maya endawenindâgwak, abinôdjînsh.

Jack throws a red fireball at Kagagi, which strikes him in the chest and sends him tumbling across the dirt! He rises, slowly. As Jack descends before him.

JACK (CONT'D)

I thought you would be the one to
do it; to defeat the Windigo.
Nigî-inwâz kîn ked-ayâwiyamban
kidji-dôdaman; kidji-bakiniwadj
Wîndigo.

Jack punches Kagagi, sending him flying backward. He advances
as Kagagi rises.

JACK (CONT'D)

So much time and effort and for
what? The one who never believed
that all along...
Kinwej ashidj kagetan ânimiziwin
awegonen ondje? Owa ega kâ-
debwetang kabehî...

Jack kicks Kagagi, sending him down once more onto the dirt.

JACK (CONT'D)

Was you!
Kîn âwiyamban!
*

Kagagi rolls over, comes up firing energy discs that Jack
dodges, swerving in midair. Jack grabs the hero by the arms! *

Kagagi's eyes glow brightly.

KAGAGI

It's me that has to fight the *
Windigo. Me! You all think you know *
how, but none of you will-- None of *
you can, but me!
Nîn `e mâmakâdj ke-mîgânag Wîndigo. Nîn! Kakina
kidinenindizom kashkitôyeg, kâwin tash kiga-dôdazîm
- Kâwin endachiyeg kigashkitôsîm, nîn igodj eta.
*

Kagagi thrusts his arms outward, sending Jack flying
backward!

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

I... Don't... Need... You!
Kâ'n... Kidanda...Wenimisi...Nôn! *

Jack erupts in a burst of light! Kagagi, exhausted, falls
onto all fours, BREATHING heavily. *

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

I don't need you.
Kâ'n kidandawenimisinôn.

The Windigo roars with deep, evil LAUGHTER over head. *

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Tommy stands before Cassie. She holds her cell phone and taps
at it furiously.

TOMMY

What's so important?

Awegonen kechi-gitâmigwenindâgwak?

She turns the phone toward him. *

CLOSE-UP: *

She's brought up Weirdfiles on her phone. *

CASSIE

This.

Awaso.

Tommy leans in and examines the site. *

TOMMY

I'm not getting the point.

Kâ'n ninisodatanzî.*

CASSIE

When was the last time you read the comments, Tommy? *

Ânapîch ishkwâyâdj kâ-nâbwâdaman ekidonâniwang, Tommy?

Tommy looks confused. Cassie turns the phone back toward herself and reads off the screen.

CASSIE (CONT'D)

"Dear Weirdfiles, thanks so much for this site. I used to be scared of monsters. But you've helped me face my fears." *

" K î n a w a M a m â n d â -
 e s h k w e m a g ô n , k i c h i - m î g w e c h
 o n d j e k i k e n i n d a m ô j i w e -
 a b i n â s . N i g o s â b a n e g
 k a g w e t â d j i c h i g a n a g . A n i s h a
 t a s h k i g î - w î d ô k a w i m k i d j i -
 g i j i g â b a n d a m â n s a y e g î g o y â n "

TOMMY

Yeah, well. You're welcome, who ever you are. *

Â n h , m î ` s a . K â ' n k e g o w î n
 ` e , a w e g w e n i w a n e n . *

Tommy, shakes his head and half turns from Cassie. *

CASSIE

Or this. Listen: "Weirdfiles, you showed me that it's okay-- heck, cool to be weird... That it's possible to be yourself and do what you love. Thank you." Signed... *

Konima kaye awaso. Pizindan: "Mamândâ-eshkwemag, kigî-wâbandahim ega kego inzinog - âwiyege mamândâwizidj... kidji-gashkitôn tibinawe âwiyen ashidj kechi-minwenindaman tôdaman. Mîgwech." Kâ- ojobîhigedj...Cassie Shannon.

*

Tommy looks up at Cassie, surprised. *

TOMMY *

Really?
Kagetinâm na?

Cassie puts her hand of Tommy's shoulder. *

CASSIE *

Don't give up on us Tommy. We're on
to something here...

Kâwin pagidenimishkângen Tommy. Kego igodj
kimikânânân `ondaje. *

Cassie walks off, leaving the bag on the ground, in front of
Tommy. *

He stands motionless, looking down at it for a moment, before
picking it up. *

EXT. ALLEYWAY - NIGHT *

The minions swivel their heads back and forth, looking for
Nigig.

MINION 1

Where'd he go?
Ândî apane?

MINION 2

Dunno. Probably good hider. Very
little.
'Dogwen. Konima nitâ-gâzowidok. Kichi-agâshînshe. *

The other minion considers this and nods.

Nigig is crouched behind a dumpster. He holds a rock in his
hand and throws it a few feet away from the minions. *

MINION 2 (CONT'D)

What was that?
Awegonen tash wîn `e?.*

MINION 3

Maybe a cat. A scaredy-cat!
Kâjagens konima. Kâjagens kwetâdjidj! *

Minion 1 and Minion 3 laugh at Minion 2. *

Nigig cups his hands over his mouth and talks, throwing his
voice, and speaking in a deep, menacing tone! *

NIGIG *

What a pleasant surprise! Some
small, delicious looking things
have walked into my lair!
Nigichi-mino-goshkose!
Agâshînsheg ,
menopogozinâgozidjig kî-bi-
bîndigeg endajitôyân.

MINION 2

I told you! Stupid minions.
Kigî-ininom! Pizinâdizî abanîdok.

*

MINION 1

Who's there?

*

Awenin endanizidj?

NIGIG

*

Come, let us see which of you
tastes best with... Some fava beans
and a nice Chianti!

*

*

Ondâs, awenîn kînawa mayâmindji-minopogozidj
mâmawe... Pangî ozâyînsan ashidj meniwâgamig Chianti!

Minion 3 looks even more scared than his terrified
companions.

MINION 3

Maybe... Should go tell Windigo?

Konima... Awi-wîndamawindj Wîndigo?

*

MINION 1

No! Windigo will punish minions for
not fighting.

Kâwin! Wîndigo oga-bashajewân abanîn ega mîgâkînidj.*

Nigig with his menacing voice LAUGHS heartily! The minions
react with panic.

*

ALL MINIONS

We go... We go!

Mâdjâdâ ... Mâdjâdâ!

The minions swoop up into the sky; Nigig watches them go,
then CHUCKLES to himself.

*

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

*

The Windigo speaks as the camera spins around Kagagi.

WINDIGO

Why is it so hard for you to see
that your worst enemy is you?

*

Awegonen wendji-ânimiziyen kidji-wâbandaman kîn 'e
kimîgâdinowâganandizoyen?

*

A bright flash of light. Kagagi shields his eyes - when he
opens them, we see them grow wide with fear.

KAGAGI'S POV:

*

An evil Kagagi, red eyes, stands before Kagagi.

*

EVIL KAGAGI

Here he is... The guest of honour.

Mî awasowa...Meyadâwizidj payâbîchiganiwidj.

*

Evil Kagagi throws a brutal punch at the screen.

*

The Windigo LAUGHS with pleasure.

*

INT. JACK'S WAREHOUSE - NIGHT *

Nigig is out of breath and he enters. *

JACK

There you are. Thought I'd lost
you, buddy. *

Mî nôgona 'indaje endaniziwambanen. Nigî-inwâz kî-
wanînân, wîdjikiwe. *

Nigig turns and points at him. *

NIGIG

You abandoned me! I was accosted!
Attacked!

Kigî-nagadjibahi! Nigî-nakwenigô! Nigî-mawininigo!

JACK

Accosted *and* attacked? No way. By
whom? *

Nakwenigo ashidj mawininigo? Kâ maninâg. Awenîn?

Nigig holds two fingers in front of the mock-startled Jack,
then adds a third. *

NIGIG

Two Windigo minions. Oh, no,
wait... There were *three*. *

Nîj Wîndigo abanîg. Oh, keshk... Nisîbaneg. *

Jack shakes his head. *

NIGIG (CONT'D)

You set this up, led me right to
them! Didn't you? This isn't funny,
I was—

Kîn kidinanokîwin iyo, kigî-gikinôwij maya igodj
'îndî igeg! Keget na? Kâ'n niwîyadenindazî, ni-- *

Jack smiles at his friend.

JACK

Pretty awesome, really. Although, I
gotta admit, that rooftop leap; I
didn't see that coming. Those legs
ain't built for jumping.

Agwânisagâdj, kegetinâm. Anisha tash, kenwek igodj iye
apakwân iji-gwâshkwaniwin; kâ'n wîn 'e nigî-
bîdâbandazîn. Inen okâdan kâ'n ijichigâdesinôn kidji-
gwâshkwaniwânîwang. *

Nigig looks offended!

JACK (CONT'D)

I'd have caught you. It's what
 friends do; help you realize you
 can still stand on your own two
 feet. *

Kidâgî-nakwebinin. Mî iye wîdjikiweyag
 Endôdamowâdj; kidji-wîdôkâgôn kikenindaman kîyâbadj
 kashkitôn nânîbawin nishike mâmawe nîj kizidan. *

Nigig frowns, before CHUCKLING, despite his best efforts. *

NIGIG

Wisakedjerk. *

Wîsakedjbizinâd.

EXT. NIGIG'S TESTING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE) *

Kagagi and Evil Kagagi trade moves, going blow for blow -
 neither can land a meaningful shot as they are a perfect
 match for one another; with one exception. Evil Kagagi looks
 to be fresh, as Kagagi himself looks exhausted. *

EVIL KAGAGI

What's wrong? Getting tired of
 hurting yourself?
 Ânîn endiyen? Kijagadji-wîsigâpinandidiz na? *

Enraged, Kagagi misses a punch and Evil Kagagi counters with
 an elbow to the midsection, a backward fist to the cheek and
 then flips Kagagi over hard onto the dirt!

EVIL KAGAGI (CONT'D)

Get up! We're not done!
 Pazigwîn! Kâwin kidishkwâtâsîmin! *

KAGAGI

(to himself) *

I don't know how much more of this
 I can take.
 Kâ'n nigîkenindazîn minigik awaso ke-odâpinamawânen.

Evil Kagagi spin-kicks him, then follows that up with several
 red energy disc blasts that send him flying back against a
 large rock. *

EVIL KAGAGI

How much more of what? The truth?
 Ânîdok minigik awegonen? Tebwewin?

Kagagi rises, looking puzzled and is jacked up against the
 rock by Evil Kagagi.

EVIL KAGAGI (CONT'D)

We've come for you now, Kagagi.
 Âjaye kibi-nâniminimin Kâgâgî. *

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Tommy walks down the street, deep in thought.

TOMMY (V.O.)

(thinking)

Maybe Cassie is right. Maybe I
should keep going, no matter how
scared I am.

Konima Cassie kwayakoshinidok. Konima kagândj
ijâyân, misawâdj igodj ked-iji-gotâdjîwânen.

Tommy pauses as we hear a familiar sound overhead... The
black aircraft and it's engines, ROARING.

Tommy reacts at first, but as the engines grow louder, that
turns to defiance and then, a look of righteousness crosses
his face.

The aircraft passes directly overhead as Tommy looks up at
it, a grim look of determination on his face.

TOMMY

That's it! You've got no right to
spy on us. Maybe it's time someone
spied on you...

Mî âjaye tibiseg iye! Kâ'n kidijichigewinisî kidji-
gîmôzâbamiyâng. Konima âjaye odjidisedok kîn'tam
kîmôzâbamigôn. *

EXT. NIGIG'S TRAINING GROUNDS - DAY (DREAM SEQUENCE)

Evil Kagagi throttles Kagagi against the rock.

The Windigo approaches them, smiling.

WINDIGO

What an ending for the mighty
Kagagi. I just had to sit back and
watch you destroy yourself.

Kichi-mamândâ-ishkwâse ondje iya kechi-zazegâwidj Kâgâgî. Eta
igodj nigî-ajeb kidji-gijigâbaminân nishawinâdjîdizon.

Evil Kagagi's grip tightens. Kagagi GASPS for breath. His eye
glow dims.

KAGAGI

You... You're right. I get it now.
All of this; my fears... Worries.
I've been fighting them... Losing
to them.

Kîn... Kigwayakoshin. Âjaye nigîkenindân. Kakina
awaso, nigotâdjîwinan... Nôdjânimenindamiwinan.
Kabehî nimîgâdânan... Nibakinwâgonan.

The Windigo smiles.

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

But that's not what I have to do.

Anisha tash kâ'n âwanzinôn `e ked-inanokîyân.

Windigo looks puzzled, as Evil Kagagi raises his eyebrows.

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

They're a part of me. I can't deny
them. I need... To own them!

Nimâmawopiz mâmawe igen. Kâwin nigashkitôsî kidji-
ânawetamân. Mâmakâdj ke-... tibenindamân!

Kagagi shrugs off Evil Kagagi and opens his arms out wide!
Evil Kagagi shrieks as he is absorbed, sucked into Kagagi!
Kagagi's eyes glow bright yellow once more as he hovers into
the air looking refreshed, rejuvenated!

KAGAGI (CONT'D)

This is over. I know I can adapt. I
can overcome. I am Kagagi!

Ishkwâse iyo. Nigîkenindân kidji-ani-nagadiziyân.
Niga-jâbwînodân. Nigâgâgîw!

The Windigo ROARS, enraged and seems to grow... Bit by bit,
larger and larger until he looms over Kagagi!

WINDIGO

You are a fool, and you are no
match for me here! This time,
Kagagi, I will crush you!

Kibiziinâdiz, kâ'n nâsâb kîn tash kaye nîn
ondajimâ!Nôngom tash,Kâgâgî, kiga-bagishkawin!

Kagagi takes a fighting stance as the gigantic Windigo
charges at him furiously, Windigo prepares a mighty blow but
as he nears Kagagi we see him stretching, elongating
backward, up and out of the dream world.

WINDIGO (CONT'D)

What? No!
Awegonen? Kâwin!

The Windigo is sucked upward, out of this world. Kagagi looks
puzzled as he watches him go.

INT. MATTHEW AND JANET'S HOUSE - MATTHEW'S ROOM - NIGHT

Matthew sits upright, suddenly. He PANTS, looks around and
realizes he is back home. He shakes the cobwebs from his head
and looks at his window. A very different dreamcatcher hangs
in the window.

MATTHEW

What the?
Awegonen tash?

He rises, examines it, then smiles. He reaches for his phone
and dials a number.

MATTHEW (CONT'D)

Jack? Yeah, hey... Yeah I know it's *
late-- Listen! Thanks for the *
dreamcatcher. It worked wonders... *
What? If you didn't put it there, *
who did?
Jack? Enh, enh, ne... Enh enh nigîkenindân
wîkâdiwang - Pizindan! Mîgwech ondje wejibâbandasab.
Kitângogaje kî-minobizo... Awegonen? Kîshpin ega kîn
kî-asadj `indaje, awenîn kâ-asâdj?

Matthew walks over to the dreamcatcher and holds it gently in *
his hand. *

Panning out of Matthew's window and into the neighbourhood, A *
red-armored girl kneels on an opposing rooftop, watching *
Matthew, though he can't see her. She leaps into the sky. *

END OF ACT TWO

FADE OUT.
