
The Ten Commandments and the Two New Commandments

What you will need:

- A printout of page 2 (preferably on colored construction paper/cardstock)
- A thin dowel stick
- Cotton or string
- Adhesive tape
- Craft glue (optional)

Instructions

- Cut out the Commandment tablet and the heart on page 2.
- Fasten a short piece of cotton/string to the back of the tablet, and another to the back of the heart with adhesive tape.
- Tie the other ends of the cotton to the dowel stick as shown below.
- Tie a piece of cotton to the middle of the dowel stick and shift it along the stick until it balances perfectly. Tie a loop at the top so that the mobile can be hung in a place where it can rotate freely in a breeze. (Optional: place a drop of craft glue on each knot to keep it from shifting along the stick.)



The New Commandments

(see Matthew 22:37-40)

1. Love the Lord your God with all your **heart** and with all your **soul** and with all your **mind**.

2. Love your neighbor as yourself.

All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

The Ten Commandments

(see Exodus 20:4-17)

- 1. You must only worship the true God.
- 2. Do not let anything take God's place in your heart.
- 3. Do not use the Lord's name thoughtlessly or as a swearword.
- 4. Keep the Lord's Day just for Him and let it be a day of rest.
- 5. Respect and obey your parents.
- 6. Do not take someone else's life.
- 7. Be loyal to the person you are married to.
- 8. Do not take something that does not belong to you.
- 9. Do not say anything untrue about someone else.
- 10. Do not long for the things others have.
