

Paul's prison chains

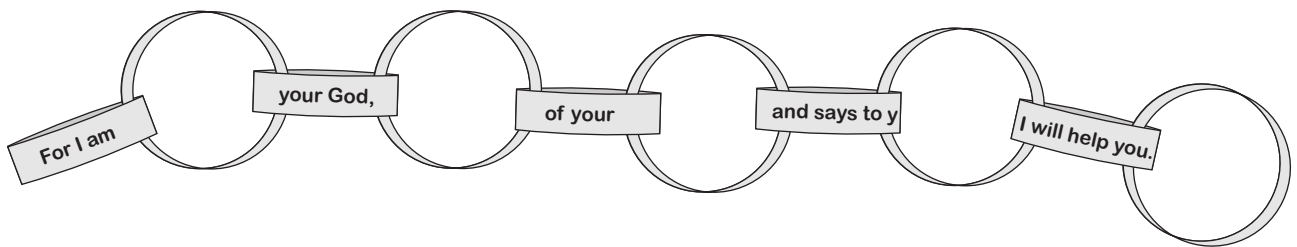
This craft will remind children of Paul's hardship and how he suffered for the Gospel. It also has the memory verse, which encourages and reassures those who are going through a tough time, perhaps because of their faith.

Things you will need:

- The template printed on A4 card or paper (preferably light gray).
- Paper glue.
- Scissors.

Construction

- Cut the template along the solid lines to form strips.
- Spread a little glue at the one end of the first strip and glue it to the other end to form a circle.
- Slip the second strip through the first link and glue it as indicated above.
- Continue adding links to the chain, being careful to get them in the right order. (The links are numbered to make it easier.)
- Note: It is better to cut off one strip at the time and glue it in place, than to cut all the strips and get them mixed up or lose them.
