

Breastplate of Righteousness

What you will need:

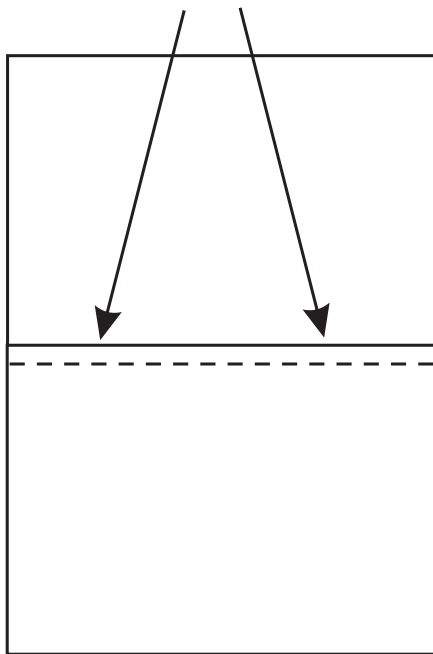
- Two sheets with lines per breastplate, printed on construction paper (card).
A copy of the 'Righteousness' strip printed on card.
- Two blank sheets of construction paper (card) per breastplate.
- Scissors
- A punch
- Tin foil (Aluminum foil)
- String
- Craft glue (white glue), glue stick.
- Plastic cup or similar sized round object.

Construction

- Follow the instructions on pages 2 and 3.

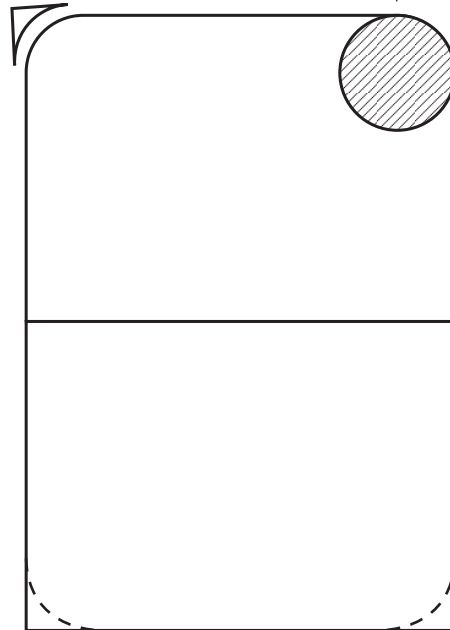


Glue two blank sheets together along the length of the sheet using a glue stick.



Cut the four corners

Use a plastic cup to draw a rounded corner



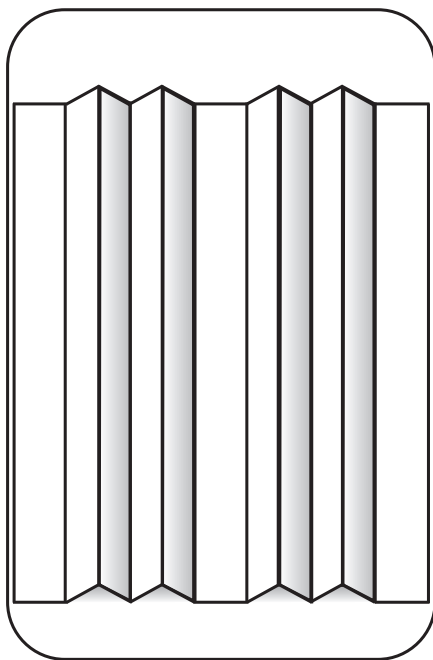
Glue the two zig-zag strips onto the back of the breastplate, as shown below.

View from the short end

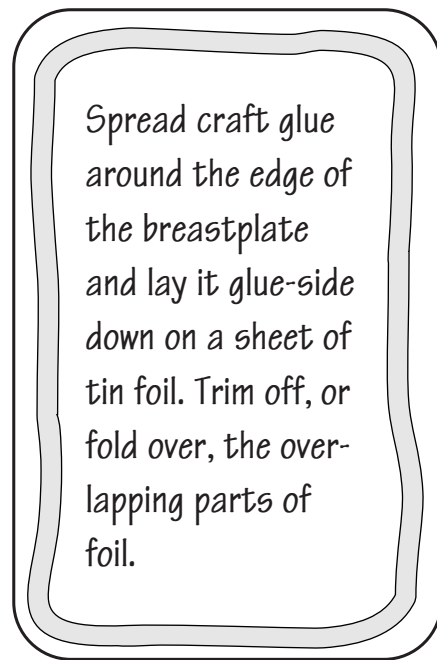

Front

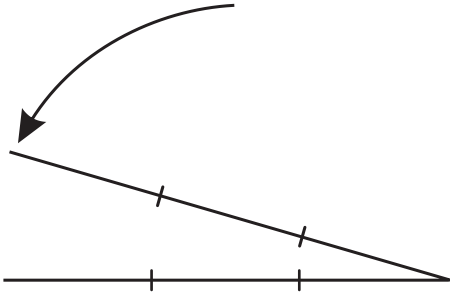


Glue the 'Righteousness' strip on the front

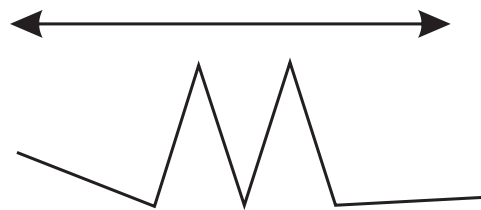
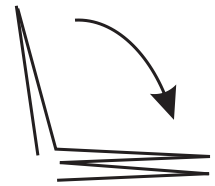
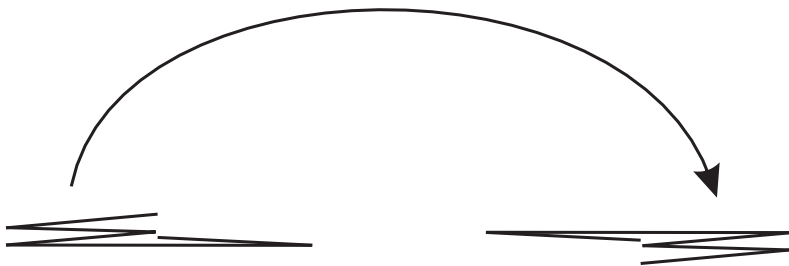
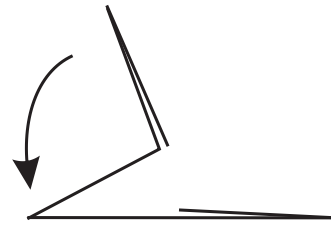
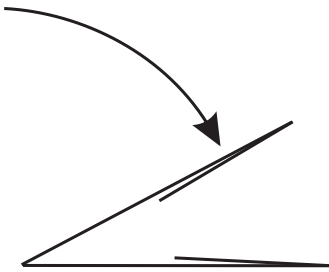
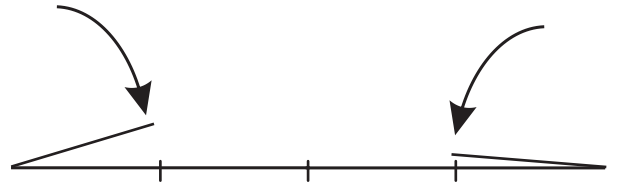
RIGHTEOUSNESS

Punch a hole in the top corners to tie on a string that loops around the child's neck.

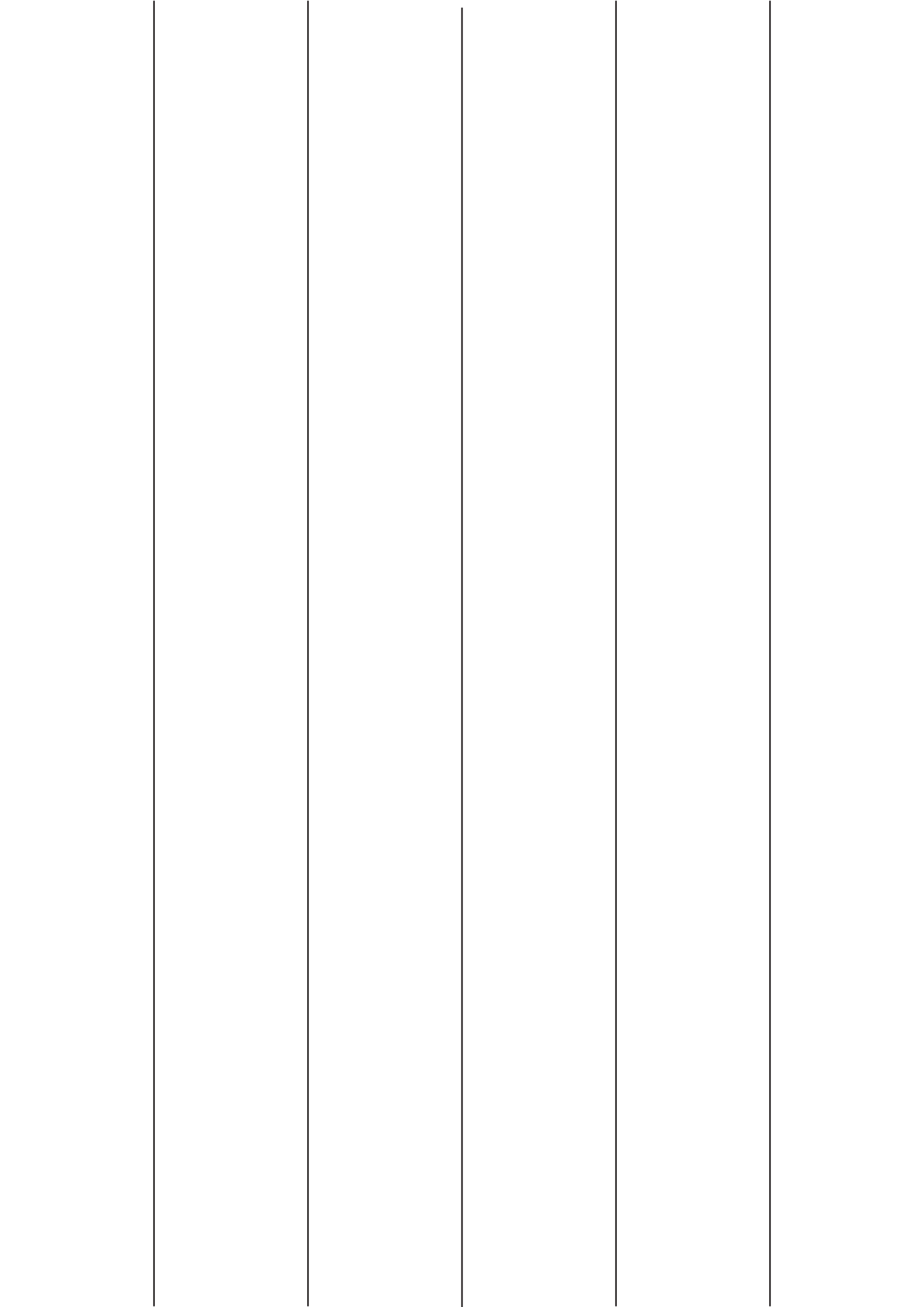
The zig-zag fold
