(Use pony beads and a nylon cord.)

Dark - reminds us of sin. Romans 3:23



Red - reminds us of Jesus' blood, when he died for our sin. John 1:7

- White reminds us of a clean heart. Psalm 51:7
- Green reminds us to grow and become more like Jesus. 2 Peter 3:18
- O Gold reminds us of our eternal life in heaven. John 14:2

f you want to ask Jesus to make your heart new, here is a prayer you can pray:

Because Jesus died to take away sin, he can make **your** heart clean. When your heart is clean, God's Spirit can come and live in you and make you part of God's family.
