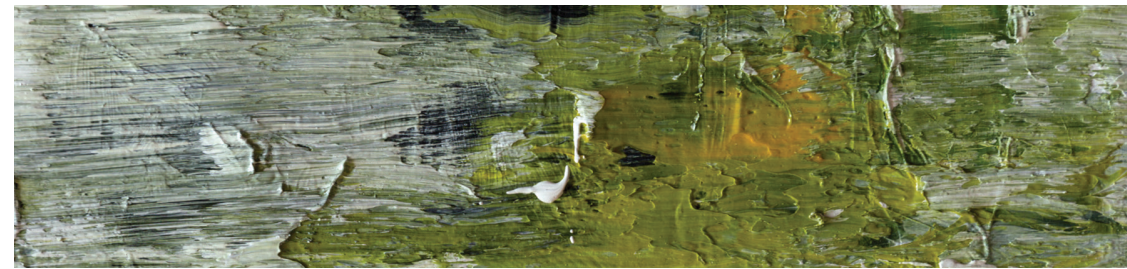

Fourth Street Heritage Corridor

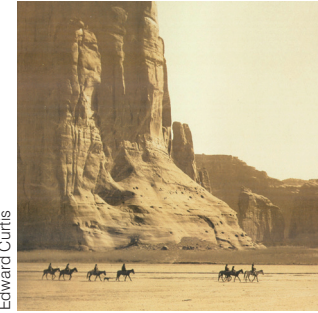
Each spring through fall, four blocks along Fourth Street in Ketchum are lined with sculptures from various artists and juried by the Ketchum Arts Commission.

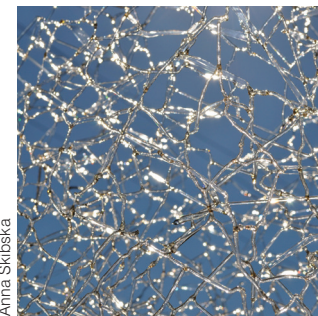

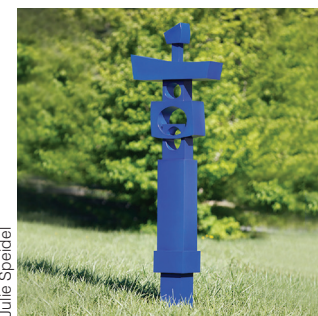

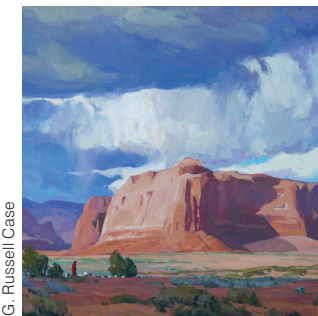
