

**BOREALIS BULLSEYES
TEAM SELECTION PROCEDURES
COMPETITIVE TEAM, DEVELOPMENT TEAM**

A. ELIGIBILITY

1. To be eligible for the Borealis Bullseyes Competitive Team (BBCT) or Borealis Bullseyes Development Team (BBDT), an individual must be a U.S. citizen and a Borealis Bullseyes Member.
2. All BBCT / BBDT shooters must sign and abide by the current Borealis Bullseyes Shooting Code of Conduct, and sign the Athlete's Agreement and Liability Release form as approved by Borealis Bullseyes. The Borealis Bullseyes documents must be signed as presented and may not be modified.

B. TRAINING TERM

The training term will begin at the conclusion of the ASD Rifle Season each year and conclude with the National Junior Olympic Championship match in the summer.

C. SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR BOREALIS BULLSEYES DEVELOPMENT TEAM (BBDT)

All current BB athletes are BBDT members and as such are eligible to compete for slot positions for BBCT.

D. SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR BOREALIS BULLSEYES COMPETITIVE TEAM (BBCT)

1. BBDT members who are a current USAS member and CMP member.
2. Regular members of the BBCT shall be selected from the top scoring individuals at the following matches:

10m Air Rifle

Alaska State Junior Olympic Rifle Championship
U.S. Army Junior Open Postal
American Legion Postal
Alaska State Junior Olympic 3 Position Air Rifle Championship
NRA Sectional Postal Match
Other events as designated by the Head Coach

NOTE: This will be a competitive as well as a participation based system with all slots being available for acquisition at any time.

Scores and individual placing will be posted for all matches, however membership to the BBCT and the right to travel and compete will be based on the members ability to meet all criteria.

E. BOREALIS BULLSEYES COMPETITIVE TEAM POLICY

1. The Borealis Bullseyes Competitive Team will consist of four team members and an alternate to compete in scheduled competitions. Any BBCT member may be moved to the BBDT at any time by recommendation of the Head Coach based on the following criteria:
 - a. Lack of progress in demonstrated performance.
 - b. Attitude
 - c. Failure to attend required activities / fund raising events.
 - d. Code of Conduct violation.
 - e. Failure to attend required practices.
2. Borealis Bullseyes Competitive Team members must participate in the training and competitive activities established by the Head Coach and Board. Shooters who cannot carry out an active training program subsequent to their selection may be relegated to the Borealis Bullseyes Development Team by action of the Head Coach. All shooters selected to the BBCT or BBDT will work with the Head Coach in designing and carrying out a training program that will assure maximum performance.

F. SCHOLASTIC TEAM PARTICIPATION AS BOREALIS SCHOLASTIC TEAM

Scholastic teams without a participating scholastic coach may participate as Borealis Bullseyes Scholastic sponsored teams, and as such utilize Borealis facilities, equipment, funds, coaching and other services. Structure for the scholastic team will be as the Competitive Team above. All members must adhere to all Borealis Bullseyes rules and guidelines. All practices and training plans etc as decreed by the Head Coach must be followed in order to compete and travel as a Borealis Bullseyes Scholastic Team. This includes attending required practice sessions and club related activities/fund raising events.
