Possible Reasons for Rider Discharge

Please be advised of the following reasons that may lead to discharge from the riding program.

1. The Rider has reached all of his/her goals and is ready to graduate.
2. The Rider's potential to maintain head and neck control while riding presents a safety concern.
3. The Rider's inability to follow directions is interfering with progress toward goals.
4. The Rider is uncontrolled and/or exhibits inappropriate behavior that constitutes a safety risk to other riders, him/herself, staff and/or horse(s).
5. The Rider exceeds weight that can safely be managed by staff, volunteers, and/or horses.
6. Any change in the Rider's medical, physical, cognitive, or emotional condition that makes therapeutic riding inappropriate.
7. The Rider misses three scheduled appointments without prior cancellation.
