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Consensus on Issues and Action Plan

- 1. Managed care needs to develop and increase the number of services and providers with diverse (i.e., African American, Latino, Asian, and Native American):
 - a. backgrounds
 - b. language
 - c. understanding of spiritual backgrounds
 - d. understanding of persons with non-spiritual backgrounds
 - e. Cultural competence training on all cultures.
 - f. Ancestral education
- 2. Develop a central clearinghouse for diverse populations in order to make information and services accessible. Should have e-mail and internet capabilities
- 3. Fifty percent of conference scholarships should go to persons with diverse backgrounds. Panelists at the conferences should come from diverse backgrounds.
- 4. National anti-stigma campaign dealing with issues facing people of color who have mental illness.
 - a. Speakers Bureau made up of people from diverse cultures who speak and educate on their culture.
 - b. Speakers Bureau that is driven by and focuses on young people and mental health issues from diverse cultures.
 - c. Speakers Bureau that focuses on educating the elderly
 - d. Police training
 - e. Cable access programs
- 5. Develop support networks with outreach to communities and families.
- 6. Sovereignty developed outside the state or county mental health system, specifically when dealing with Alaska Natives.
- 7. Annual people of color conference.
- 8. Voter/political education
