

Requirements for Hosting PNWLL Games

Provide the following items for use during the day:

- 2 goals/field lines
- yellow NOCSAE-certified game balls (at least 3 balls – more is better)
- 10 cones to mark restraining lines, end lines and the sub box
- Table/chairs (a tent is nice too, especially on rainy days!)
- First aid kit and Ice
- Score board or other visible score signage
- Stopwatches/timing devices (phones work great)
- Score sheet (found in the documents section of pnwll.com)
- Horn (optional)

Requirements of your team before and after game day:

- Ensure the field has Women's lacrosse field lines and goals before the 1st game*
- Create a schedule for table duties*
- Ensure score sheets are signed by the table and officials for each game
- Report scores to pnwll.info@gmail.com within 48 hours of the game

** Grass fields can be painted but we CANNOT paint turf fields. Tape will need to be used on any unlined turf fields. PNWLL will do the best they can to schedule all league games on turf fields, lined for women's lacrosse. If you host a weekend of games and the field is not already lined, you are required to line the field and may submit receipts for paint/tape to the league treasurer for reimbursement.*

** Your team can handle table duties on your own if it is a single game day. For days with multiple games occurring, you may also choose to assign table duties to other teams as well. Other teams can help with the table when they are not already scheduled to play a game. If utilizing other teams for table duties, the schedule of table duties must be sent out at least 1 week in advance. You can e-mail this to pnwll.info@gmail.com for distribution to the teams.*
