The first weekend of June takes the thousands of Ford Faithful to the Carlisle Fairgrounds for the All-Ford Nationals. In it's 15th year, Carlisle Productions has finally gotten the blessing of Ford Motor Company to be rechristened the "Carlisle Ford Nationals" and with it the ability to use the iconic blue oval logo we have been waiting for. Ford has been coming to Carlisle for a few years now but it's presence was really felt this year. The Carlisle Expo Center was filled with the latest products from Ford, Lincoln and Mercury on display. Outside the Expo, licensed drivers over 18 could drive a number of products from the Fiesta to the F150, but the line was longest waiting to test drive the 2011 V6 powered 6 speed manual transmission Mustang. In the Manufacturer's Midway, Ford Racing had a large display of parts and crate engines, the Mustang Garage was buzzing with activity and Ford had plenty of Mustangs and Shelbys to look over, Fiestas too.

As usually happens, the weather was hot and humid bringing a thunderstorm in Friday afternoon, but Saturday and Sunday were just hot, but the crowds didn't seem to notice. The vendor area wasn't as full as in past years, probably a result of the economy and the growth of internet shopping, but the showfield seemed to be filled to capacity. Cobra Jet Mustangs, old and new, were among the featured vehicles this year, and there were many on display including the only late model factory Cobra Jet Mustang convertible. Several legendary Cobra Jet racers were on hand signing autographs, among them was former Rice and Holman Cobra Jet driver Al Joniec.

In addition to all the cars and parts to see, in recent years Carlisle has added a "Cool Club Hangout" award. This year the competition was fierce between all the participants with some really interesting themes. Checking out the "hangouts" was a lot of fun.

Also among the must see activities, the Burnout contest! If you participate, plan on bringing plenty of spares! Always a crowd favorite at Carlisle!

I hope you will participate in some of these upcoming club activities.




