

Dear Family in Christ,

The purpose of St. John's Lutheran School is to help families pass their faith in the Lord Jesus to their children through a Christ-centered educational program and to develop their God-given gifts.

Financial scholarships are available through AGAPE, Chicago Lutheran Educational Foundation (CLEF), and the Henry Knueppel School Endowment Fund. These funds were set up to help parents realize for their children the above stated purpose. Unforeseen circumstances such as illness, loss of jobs, family break ups, or death keep some of our families from having funds to cover the entire cost of St. John's tuition, and these funds can provide temporary help. Tuition assistance may not be more than one half of the total cost of the tuition for each family in any given year. Enclosed is the *Tuition Assistance Application*. Monies will be distributed to families, after review of the application, as determined by the Committee which consists of the Pastor, Principal, BOCE member and Business Manager.

#### AGAPE FUND

- Monies from this fund are for active member families who meet the criteria of an active member of St. John's.

#### HENRY KNUEPPEL SCHOOL ENDOWMENT FUND

- Monies from this fund are available to any family that was enrolled in the previous school year, or any new family for the second semester of enrollment.

#### CHICAGO LUTHERAN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION (CLEF)

- Monies from this fund are available for any family at St. John's. Families receiving tuition assistance from this fund must write a thank-you letter to the foundation.
