¹New Family *Early Registration Bonus (ERB)*

- The New Family *Early Registration Bonus (ERB)* is immediately available for new families registering full day students in **pre school through eighth grade**.
- Register before June 1, 2016 and receive \$1,000 off of tuition.
- Registrations received June 1 through June 30 will receive \$500 off of tuition.

²*Split-a-Grand*

In addition, new families who register **full time students in Pre School through eighth grade (PS – 8)** will receive their half of *Split-a-Grand* which will be \$500 off of tuition. A currently registered family who recommended St. John's to you will receive the other half of *Split-a-Grand*.

* Note: The *ERB* and *Split-a-Grand* may be deducted evenly to lower the monthly payments, applied to the last payments of the year, or applied at the beginning. The *ERB* and *Split-a-Grand* are applicable if payments are made in the timely manner as marked on the Registration Application, and for those students which complete the school year. Late payments or early withdrawal will void these discounts and the regular tuition will be required.

³*Tuition Voucher*

Vouchers are the responsibility of the recipient to turn in toward 8th grade tuition!
