

# Parent Information

It is the goal of St. John's Summer Camp to provide your children with Christ-centered summer adventures. Campers will spend time indoors and outdoors as experienced counselors lead them in a wide variety of activities each day, including arts and crafts, games, sports, water activities and weekly field trips.

## **Camp is open to all children ages 3 to 12 years old.**

All campers must be completely toilet trained.

## **Camp will be offered for ten weeks (6/6/16-8/12/16) this summer.**

You may choose to send your camper for one week, a couple weeks or all ten weeks.

All campers must be pre-registered-no drop ins allowed. This is vital for proper staffing.

St. John's runs summer camp as a service for the families and not with the intentions of making money. However, expenses (counselors hired, supplies & snacks purchased, field trips paid for, etc) are incurred based on the attendance anticipated by registrations. Therefore, you are financially responsible for the weeks your camper is registered even if they don't attend. It is possible that accommodations may be made with enough notification or in the event of an extended illness.

## **3 Day and 5 Day Options**

You have the option to attend three days (Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday) or five days a week.

Other attendance options can be made on an individual basis by contacting the camp director.

## **Day Camp Hours 9:00 am - 3:00 pm**

Campers should arrive by 9 am in order to participate that day unless prior arrangements have been made with the camp director.

Campers will be divided into groups based on age. Structured, age appropriate activities will be led by experienced counselors during camp hours.

If your child will be absent on a day that they registered for, please call or text the camp director by 9:00 am.

## **Extended Hours**

Before care (7am - 9am) and after care (3pm - 6pm) is available at no additional cost.

A light breakfast (cereal, frozen pancakes, frozen waffles, etc.) will be served during before care hours.

Before and after care will offer free choice activity stations overseen by counselors.

\*\*\*If you are late to pick your child up, you will be charged \$5 for the first 10 minutes and \$1 a minute thereafter, payable the following morning.\*\*\*

## **Field Trips**

The cost of field trips is included in the camp fees. Campers must wear their St. John's Summer Camp t-shirt on field trip days. Campers must bring a disposable lunch unless told otherwise. Field trips are still being finalized but may include Pirate's Cove, Brookfield Zoo, Party Time Palace, Indian Boundary Park, Shedd Aquarium, Museum of Science & Industry, minor league baseball game, movies and bowling.
