Navigate to the **Port Macquarie News** pages and there is the option to search within this paper only. Remember that prior to 1882 there were other newspapers, such as the Sydney Morning Herald and the Maitland Mercury, that included Hastings district news, so a general search on **TROVE** will also retrieve local area news items.
