

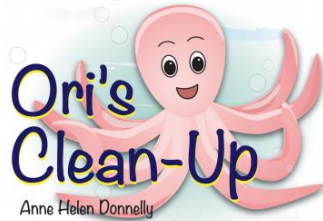

### Music For Toddlers ~ 1 year olds & Fun With Music ~ 2 & 3 year olds @ Port Macquarie Library

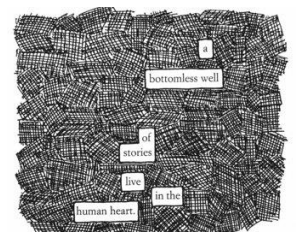
