**Line 3** – 5 syllables

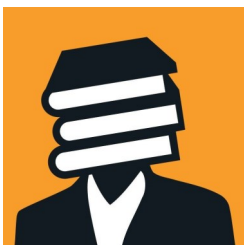
**The darkness darkened.**
