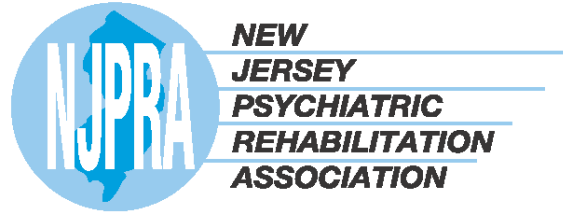
A little more about us:
