- **POSITION PAPER ON FUTURE EU RESEARCH & INNOVATION POLICIES:** In response to the EC consultation on the Green Paper on future EU Research & Innovation Policies, the Technology Platform is currently finalising a joint position paper reflecting the views of the textile industry and its research community. Individual responses to the EC consultation are still possible and highly encouraged until 20 May. - **SEVERAL NEW TEXTILE PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED UNDER 2011 CALLS OF FP7:** The 2011 calls of FP7 (launched in July 2010) have now been evaluated resulting in the final selection of some 5-6 new projects and the pre-selection (stage 1) of another about 10-12 proposals, of which one half may still be approved for funding. This makes last year one of the most fruitful and successful in terms of new textile project funding in FP7. The next round of calls is expected in July, unfortunately with less direct scope for textile research
- **2ND CROSSTEXNET CALL OPEN:** The CrossTexNet ERA-Net launched its second call in March. 11 funding agencies from 8 countries participate. Submission deadline is 31 May.
