

**Do the Work of an Evangelist**  
**(A checklist for the would-be evangelist)**

- Have I explained who God is?
  - What have I said of His character and nature?
  - Have I sought to communicate something of His holiness, justice, sovereignty, majesty, love?
  - Do they know He is the creator? (Isaiah 6:1-8; Jeremiah 9:23; 1 Timothy 1:17; 6:15&16; Genesis 1:1)
  - Have I preached the law?
  - Do they know the purpose of the law? (Deuteronomy 31:26; Romans 3:19&20; 7:7-25; Galatians 3:21-25; James 2:10)
  
- Have I explained sin? (1 John 3:4; James 4:17; Romans 3:23; 6:23; Isaiah 64:6&7; Romans 3:16-17; Romans 8:7; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Ephesians 2:1-3; 4:17-19)
  - What is it?

- Why is it so bad?
- What are its repercussions?
- What does it lead to?
- Who has sinned?
- Am I preaching the depravity of man?

Have I spent sufficient time detailing who Jesus Christ is?

- Why the Virgin Birth?
- Do they know He is fully God and fully man?
- Have I preached that he was sinless?
- Do they know why He came into the world?
- Why He died?
- Did I explain why he died on a cross?
- What did his death accomplish?
- Have I explained that he rose up?
- Do they understand the significance of the resurrection? (Matthew 1:18-24; 1 Timothy 2:5; Colossians 2:9; John 1:1-14; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter

2:22; 1 John 3:5; 1 Timothy 1:15; Mark 10:45; Hebrews 9:22; 10:10; Galatians 3:13; Romans 3:21-26; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; Romans 5:6-11; 8:34; Hebrews 7:24&25; Romans 1:1-4)

Does my audience know what God requires of them?

Have I sufficiently explained repentance?

Have I explained faith? (Acts 17:30; Acts 14:15; ! Thessalonians 1:9; 1 John 3:23; Acts 16:30&31; Luke 14:25-35; Luke 15:7; Ephesians 2:8-10; Acts 26:20)

Am I preaching God's Word or my own ideas as God's Word?


▪ Am I exalting Christ as Lord and Him alone?

Am I exalting myself? (John 14:6; Acts 4:12; 2 Corinthians 4:5; Galatians 1:6-9; 1 Corinthians 1:18-25)

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes..." Romans 1:16

- “For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but it is to us who are being saved it is the power of God... God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believed... but we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles... for I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.” 1 Corinthians 1:18-2:2.
- “For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.” I Corinthians 15:3-4
- “For we do not preach ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your servants for Jesus’ sake.” 2 Corinthians 4:5
- “But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than this one we preached to you, let him be eternally condemned! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let him

be eternally condemned! Am I now trying to win the approval of men or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be the servant of Christ." Galatians 1:8-10

 "I give you this charge: Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage – with great patience and careful instruction. For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine." 2 Timothy 4:1b-3
