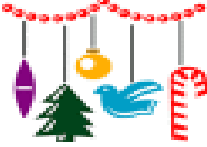

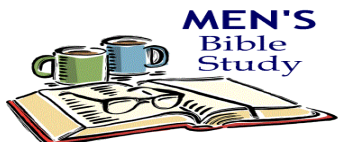

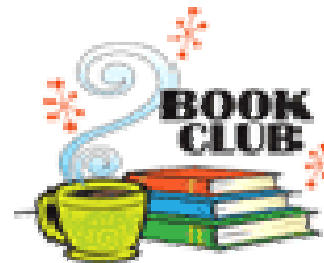

The author uses the small town of Carriveau as a main setting that dramatically contrasts with the evil that is about to come to a country that has surrendered to the Nazis and is now being occupied. While the city of Paris takes in most of the heat, the quiet village of Carriveau is on the brink of changing forever. The once peaceful and bucolic town has turned into a horrific show of airplanes, war tanks, bombs, and the scary sight of Nazis. The two sisters each deal with this evil in their own way in this heart-stopping novel.

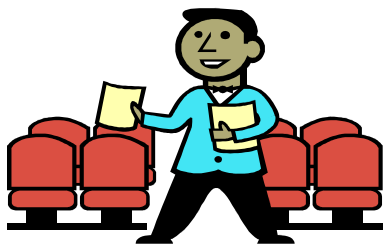

### **Jesse Tree**

This Advent season we are blessed to continue our tradition. A Jesse Tree Banner will be in our sanctuary and used in our Advent worship together. The Jesse Tree provides a great focal point for our worship this Advent. Each Sunday and Wednesday worship will be a symbol from this as our particular theme for that day.

The Jesse Tree is named from Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot will spring forth from the stump of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots." It is a vehicle to tell the story of God in the Old Testament, and to connect the Advent Season with the faithfulness of God across 4,000 years of history. The Branch is a biblical sign of newness out of discouragement, which became a way to talk about the expected messiah (e.g., Jer. 23:5). It is therefore an appropriate symbol of Jesus the Christ, who is the revelation of the grace and faithfulness of God.

We will celebrate God's faithfulness through history as He kept His promise to give us as Savior. Wednesday services begin at 6:30 PM starting on December 2<sup>nd</sup> and dinners are @ 5:15-6:15 PM make this a special season.
