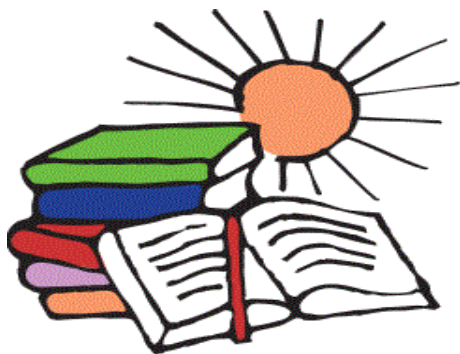

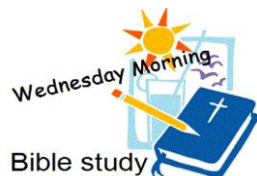

Mt. Pisgah is fortunate to have an outstanding preschool program. The program has a reputation for loving, teaching, and sending students off to kindergarten with confidence that they are ready to successfully begin public schools.

The preschool combines the best of two approaches: structure and hands-on, age-appropriate learning. Children are actively involved in play and in learning activities. Class sizes are extremely small which provide a fantastic opportunity for one-on-one instruction.

The preschool teacher, Linda Bloom, provides the experience, continuity, and creativity to ensure this outstanding preschool experience. We are blessed to have a certified teacher of Mrs. Bloom's caliber lead this program. There are classes for two age levels: three-year olds meet Tuesdays and Thursdays while four-year olds have classes Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

With the end of the school year approaching, the preschool is preparing to perform between the early and late service at approximately 9:40 on Sunday, May 19. All church members and family and friends of preschoolers are warmly invited to attend this program which is followed by a reception in Celebration Hall.
