

Evergreens:

* **Techny Arbvorvitae** - One of the favorite wind-break trees, it can grow 30-40' tall with a 10-15' spread. Medium grower (1-2' per year) with dark green, soft foliage.

* **Blue Spruce** - A highly prized ornamental evergreen. Colors vary from green to blue. Grows well while young and matures at 50-75' tall with a 10-20' spread.

* **Norway Spruce**-This fast growing spruce typically grows 40-60' tall but can get to 75-100'. Has a 25-30' spread that grows well in well drained soils.

* **Serbian Spruce**-A medium growing tree with silvery & green color to it. Hardy on well drained soil. Grows to 40-60'.

* **White Pine** - The quickest grower of the pines it typically is 50-80' tall with a 20-40' spread but can get to 150' tall in some cases. Does best in fertile, moist soil.

Hardwoods:

* **Scarlet Oak** - Grows on a wide variety of sites, including dry soil. Bright scarlet leaves in the fall.

* **Swamp Bur Oak** - Slower growing but reaches 60-80' tall. Wood used for flooring, barrels, and furniture. Excellent firewood & wildlife food source.

* **Hackberry** - A large canopy tree that can grow as tall as 75-100' tall at a medium to fast rate. Makes a great shade tree.

* **River Birch**-A common tree to moist lowlands or swampy bottomlands. Fast growing that can reach 30-40 ft. It makes an attractive landscape tree.

Shrubs & Small Trees:

* **Crabapple** - A small tree with lots of apple berries in the fall. Grows to about 6-10'. It's dense foliage provides shelter and food for birds.

* **Hazelnut**-Grows about 10' high and 10' wide in all soil types. Produces small tasty nuts tasty to both humans and animals.

* **Highbush Cranberry** - An attractive shrub that grows 8-10' tall. Showy clusters of white flowers in the Spring will produce a profusion of red berry fruit the lasts throughout the winter for wildlife, especially the birds

* **Red Osier Dogwood** - Brilliant red stems make this 7-9' tall shrub very attractive in the winter. White blossoms are appealing in the spring and the berries it produces are sought after by many birds.

* **Serviceberry**-Grows to 25'. Small, upright multi-stemmed tree. White flowers followed by delicious purplish-blue fruit which can be used for jams and pies.
