#### **EVERGREENS**

- *Eastern White Pine*-Requires full sun and rich, moist or moist sandy loams. Soft, beautiful tree that provides good wildlife habitat. Height: 50-75' Medium growth.
- *Norway Spruce*-Can grow in partial shade in well-drained soil. Hardy, dense draping branches. More tolerant to deer than pines and provides good wildlife cover. Height: 40-60' Medium growth.

#### SHRUBS & SMALL TREES

- Serviceberry-Prefers partial shade and moist to well-drained soils. Small single to multi-stemmed tree. Produces white flowers in early spring. Provides purple berries in June that is good songbird and wildlife food. Height: 6-20'- Medium growth.
- *Ninebark*-Full sun to partial shade, moist to moderately dry soils. Hardy, dense, compact grower with small foliage and produces clusters of white flowers in May. Good wildlife food and cover. Height: 5-9' Fast growing.
- *Redosier Dogwood*-Full sun or partial shade and wet to well-drained soils. A very adaptable shrub with attractive bright red stems. Produces cream flowers followed by white berries. Good wildlife cover and food. Height: 10-15' Fast growing.
- *Gray Dogwood*-Full sun or partial shade and moist to well-drained soils. However, is adaptable to tough sites like poor fertility, dry compacted areas. Produces cream flowers followed by white berries that provide fruit and winter cover for songbirds, pheasants and grouse. Height: 10-15' Fast growing.
- *Highbush Cranberry*-Full sun to partial shade and deep, moist to well drained soils. This shrub provides showy clusters of white flowers followed by bright red berries that hold all winter. Excellent wildlife food and cover. Host plants for Azure butterflies and food for many other butterflies. Height: 8-12' Medium growth.

#### **Trees**

- *Black Oak*-Requires full sun and moist to well-drained soils. Acorns provide good wildlife food. Fall color: red to red brown. Height: 50-70' Medium growth.
- *Red Oak*-Requires full sun and moist to well-drained soils. Valuable wood products, acorns provide good wildlife food. Fall color: Red to red-brown Height: 60-80' Fast growing.
- *Pin Oak*-Requires full sun and moist to well-drained soils. Pyramidal shape, small acorns offer good wildlife food. Fall color: Bright red. Height: 60-80' Medium growth.
- **Swamp White Oak**-Requires full sun and prefers wet soil but will grow in well-drained. Acorns provide excellent wildlife food. Fall color: Yellow-brown. Height: 50-60' Medium growth.
- *Hackberry*-Full sun to partial shade and moist to well-drained soil. Host plant for several butterflies. The fruit is sought after by many birds and mammal species. Fall color: Yellow. Height: 50-70' Medium growth.
- *Northern Pecan*-Full sun and deep, moist well-drained soil. This tree provides nuts which are edible to people and wildlife. Fall color: yellow. Height: 70-100' Medium growth.
- *Black Walnut*-Requires full sun and deep, moist and well-drained soil. Provides nuts which are edible by humans and wildlife. Fall color: yellow. Height: 50-80' medium growth.
- *Black Cherry*-Full sun to partial shade and prefers moist, well-drained soil. Small cherries are an excellent source of food for birds and wildlife. Fall color: yellow. Height: 50-60' Medium growth.
